BACKGROUND: (Continued)

On July 27, 2011, the Redevelopment Agency entered into an agreement with SC Engineers to provide commissioning services for the project in the amount of \$44,000. Commissioning services is a process of ensuring that systems are designed, installed, and functionality tested by the contractor. It also includes testing for the capability of being operated and maintained to perform in conformity with the design of the overall project. Due to the complexity of the project, the scope of services with SC Engineers has been expanded to include Building Automation Standards. This includes but is not limited to the review of the HVAC, plumbing, irrigation, and electrical construction documents. Additionally, an integrated building automation standard for this project and the review of submittals related to system integration, facility controls and automation for conformance to the Building Automation Standards will be provided.

This contract is reflected on the Initial Recognized Obligation Schedule prepared by the Successor Agency. Other services provided may include but are not limited to the following as needed such as weekly construction meetings, construction schedule reviews, monthly pay application reviews, change order management, budgeting and cost estimating, value engineering, quality control and project closeout. The funding for this proposal will not be an additional cost to the project as it is accounted for in the original approved budget under miscellaneous expenses (Agenda Item 4.1, 6/28/2011) Staff recommends that the Board approve the First Amendment to the Consulting Services Agreement between Shadpour Consulting Engineers, Inc. and the County of Riverside in the amount of \$17,500.

1 **NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein
2 and providing that all other sections not amended remain intact, the parties hereto
3 agree as follows:

4 A. Section 1. of the original Agreement is hereby amended by modifying the
5 first paragraph in its entirety to read as follows:

6 1. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES. CONSULTANT shall provide all
7 services as specified within the original Agreement and Exhibit "A" thereto, and
8 this First Amendment and Exhibit "A-1" attached hereto and by this reference
9 incorporated, including but not limited to, Building Automation Standards.

10 B. Section 3 of the original Agreement is hereby amended by modifying the
11 first paragraph in its entirety to read as follows:

12 3. COMPENSATION. The COUNTY shall pay the CONSULTANT for
13 services performed and expenses incurred in an amount not-to-exceed Sixty-
14 One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$61,500). CONSULTANT shall submit
15 monthly invoices to COUNTY for progress payments based on work completed
16 to date of invoice, based on the phases of work and fees therefore set out in
17 Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "A-1". COUNTY shall reimburse CONSULTANT within
18 thirty (30) days of receipt of invoice.

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


