An annual handling fee of \$10.00, renewable each year, along with procedures to obtain identification card, is obtainable at the Regional Park and Open-Space District Headquarters.
- **Disabled service-connected American veteran residing in Riverside County will be allowed free day-use entrance for the card bearer and his or her dependent family members at County Parks. A one time handling fee of \$5.00, along with procedures to obtain identification card is obtainable at the Regional Park and Open-Space District Headquarters.
- School groups on picnics or recreational outings will pay regular fee. School
 groups on conducted approved educational tours of historic or interpretive
 facilities will pay the fees established for Park District interpretive programs.
- No day use fees are charged at the following parks: Devil's Garden, Fish Traps, Harford Springs, Indian Relic, Kabian, Maze Stone, Pine Cove, San Jacinto, Valley Hi, and Miller Park.

Passes/Discounts:

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- Day use/pedestrian passes are valid for 12 months from date of purchase.
 Includes dogs and/or horse when accompanied by cardholder. Not applicable to Lake Skinner and where vehicle pass is required for drive in.
- Vehicle pass may be used at all County parks for day-use entrance to include all occupants of vehicle. Excludes special events and holidays.
- Boat launch pass may be used at Mayflower and Lake Skinner.
- Discount vehicle pass valid for 12 months from date of purchase and may be purchased by seniors (62 & older) or qualified individuals with a disability. Excludes special events and holidays.
- Fishing books may be used at all County fishing parks. (No discount offered at Lake Skinner).
- New (first-time) park visitors may receive a 30-minute complimentary pass to preview the park and amenities. This pass is limited to first-time visitors or in circumstances deemed appropriate by the on-site designee.
- General Manager (or designee) may offer occasional complimentary (not for sale/not transferable) promotional special event passes.
- School groups on conducted educational tour of historical or interpretive facilities will be charged the fees established for Park District interpretive programs.

^{**}Note: Youth must be in school to be eligible for any discounts.

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• \$20.00 deposit for park gate key/gate card.

• Administration fee ranging between \$5.00 - \$10.00 shall be applied to refunds/transfers at all sites when applicable. Changes made due to staff error will not be charged this fee.

Refunds will be considered by General Manager, or designee, in compliance with Board of Supervisors policy J-9.

V. Fee Exemptions/Reductions

The following exemptions and reductions shall be implemented to encourage civic participation and community health, to promote education in historical, scientific and environmental awareness, and to promote park facility use in accordance with the mission of the Park District.

Fee Exemptions:

The following shall be exempt from the fees in this schedule:

- Meetings and events conducted by the members of the Board of Directors.
- Meetings and events conducted by the District.
- Activities and events specifically identified in agreements approved by the Board of Directors.

The following shall be exempt from the fees in this schedule, subject to the prior written determination of the General Manager of the District that the facility in question is available:

- Ceremonial events honoring County/District employees, appointed members of County Boards and Commissions or volunteers providing service to the County.
- Meetings and events of non-profit organizations at the request of a member, or members, of the Board of Supervisors or the Board of Directors.
- Meetings of District support groups or organizations.
- Activities and events which are organized, conducted or co-sponsored by the District.
- Training activities for County/District personnel conducted by the Riverside County Human Resources Department.

Fee Reductions:

Reduced fees shall apply to the following, subject to the prior written approval of the General Manager of the District:

- Meetings and events open to the public that are conducted by public schools, or by civic, educational, environmental, historical and athletic 501(c)(3) taxexempt, non-profit organizations.
- Official business activities of County agencies and departments and non-County governmental agencies.

BACKGROUND:

The policy requires a resolution for establishment of rates and an annual review by the District Advisory Commission. On June 7, 2011, by Minute Order 13.1, your Honorable Board approved District Resolution 2011-5, revising the fiscal year 2011-2012 use fees effective July 1, 2011.

The proposed use fees for FY 2012-13 reflect fee increases made necessary to cover expenses and coincide with the District Strategic Plan process. Main fees changes were to holiday and special events, service charges, and an adjustment to Lake Skinner Recreation Area fees to coincide with those charged at Rancho Jurupa Park for like services. A rate reduction was also done at the Cove Water Park for individuals who are 31" to 35" in height as they can't access all of the amenities offered due to the height restriction.

The changes incorporated into Resolution 2012-1 have been reviewed and approved by the District Advisory Commission at its meeting on March 1, 2012.

It is requested that your Honorable Board approve said changes and adopt Resolution 2012-1, Use Fees for the District effective July 1, 2012.

The policy requires a resolution for establishment of rates and an annual review by the District Advisory Commission. On June 7, 2011, by Minute Order 13.1, your Honorable Board approved District Resolution 2011-5, revising the fiscal year 2011-2012 use fees effective July 1, 2011.

The proposed use fees for FY 2012-13 reflect fee increases made necessary to cover expenses and coincide with the District Strategic Plan process. Main fees changes were to holiday and special events, service charges, and an adjustment to Lake Skinner Recreation Area fees to coincide with those charged at Rancho Jurupa Park for like services. A rate reduction was also done at the Cove Water Park for individuals who are 31" to 35" in height as they can't access all of the amenities offered due to the height restriction.

The changes incorporated into Resolution 2012-1 have been reviewed and approved by the District Advisory Commission at its meeting on March 1, 2012.

It is requested that your Honorable Board approve said changes and adopt Resolution 2012-1, Use Fees for the District effective July 1, 2012.





- New (first-time) park visitors may receive a 30-minute complimentary pass to preview the park and amenities. This pass is limited to first-time visitors or in circumstances deemed appropriate by the on-site designee.
- General Manager (or designee) may offer occasional complimentary (not for sale/not transferable) promotional special event passes.
- School groups on conducted educational tour of historical or interpretive facilities will be charged the fees established for Park District interpretive programs.

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U. Service Charges, Deposits, Refunds

- Service charge of \$25.00 will be applied to all checks with insufficient funds.
- \$20.00 deposit for park gate key/gate card.
- Administration fee ranging between \$5.00 \$10.00 shall be applied to refunds/transfers at all sites when applicable. Changes made due to staff error will not be charged this fee.

Refunds will be considered by General Manager, or designee, in compliance with Board of Supervisors policy J-9.

V. Fee Exemptions/Reductions

The following exemptions and reductions shall be implemented to encourage civic participation and community health, to promote education in historical, scientific and environmental awareness, and to promote park facility use in accordance with the mission of the Park District.

Fee Exemptions:

The following shall be exempt from the fees in this schedule:

- Meetings and events conducted by the members of the Board of Directors.
- Meetings and events conducted by the District.
- Activities and events specifically identified in agreements approved by the Board of Directors.

The following shall be exempt from the fees in this schedule, subject to the prior written determination of the General Manager of the District that the facility in question is available:

- Ceremonial events honoring County/District employees, appointed members of County Boards and Commissions or volunteers providing service to the County.
- Meetings and events of non-profit organizations at the request of a member, or members, of the Board of Supervisors or the Board of Directors.
- Meetings of District support groups or organizations.
- Activities and events which are organized, conducted or co-sponsored by the District.
- Training activities for County/District personnel conducted by the Riverside County Human Resources Department.

Fee Reductions:

Reduced fees shall apply to the following, subject to the prior written approval of the General Manager of the District:

 Meetings and events open to the public that are conducted by public schools, or by civic, educational, environmental, historical and athletic 501(c)(3) taxexempt, non-profit organizations. • Official business activities of County agencies and departments and non-County governmental agencies.

The General Manager shall reduce fees by 50% for those identified in this section.

Jurupa Aquatic Center - General Rules

The following rules are enforced to maintain a safe and fun environment for all of our guests:

- No running.
- No diving.
- No horseplay.
- Guests must abide by all posted rules and regulations.
- No coolers, glass containers, outside food, drinks or chewing gum.
- All bags will be searched prior to entry into the Jurupa Aquatic Center.
- Adult supervision is required at all times. Children 12 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older at a maximum of a 2 children (nonswimmers) per 1 adult ratio.
- Same Day Re-entry is permitted with valid admission receipt or hand stamp.
- Jurupa Aquatic Center is a family-friendly facility. Inappropriate behavior, language or attire are not permitted and will be grounds for refusing admission or removal from the Center without a refund.
- Jurupa Aquatic Center is a drug and tobacco free park. Drug and tobacco items are not permitted in or around the park.
- Jurupa Aquatic Center is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Guests are encouraged to use on-site lockers to store personal items.
- For guest protection, use of recording devices (cameras, video cameras & cell phones) is strictly prohibited in locker room areas and restrooms.

Dress Code:

- Traditional swimwear is required. Provocative attire, street clothes, cut-offs, and clothing with rivets, snaps, buttons, belts, or metal ornamentation are not permitted.
- Swim diapers (disposable swim diapers or plastic pants) are required for all diapered guests.
- Outside flotation devices (water wings, life vests, inflatable tubes, etc.) are not permitted.
- Snorkels, goggles and/or fins are not permitted.

Health & Safety:

- All guests must shower before entering the water.
- Guests that have experienced stomach and/or intestinal illness within the past two weeks should not enter the water.
- Guests with open wounds or bandages will not be permitted to enter the water.

- Guests are required to wash their hands after using the restroom and/or after changing a diaper. Diaper changing on or around the pool deck is not permitted.
- Do not drink the water from the pool. Drinking fountains are available for water consumption.
- The Cove/Jurupa Aquatic Center staff shall have the final authority in all matters concerning the safety of the pool and park guests.
- Inclement Weather: Jurupa Aquatic Center may close or suspend operation due to rain, electrical storms, high winds and other severe weather conditions. As soon as conditions permit safe operation, the Center will re-open. Refunds will not be issued for weather-related conditions or closures.

The Jurupa Sports Complex - General Rules

The following rules are enforced to maintain a safe and fun environment for all of our guests:

- No teams are permitted to practice on sports fields without booking through the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District.
- Smoking or consuming alcohol on or around County fields is prohibited. Violators risk losing future access to all sports fields.
- Credits for rainouts or cancellations will be honored. For cancellations made by seasonal user groups, 24 hours advance notice is required.
- Weekend request for field bookings received after 5:00 pm on the Thursday prior cannot be guaranteed.
- Only recreation vehicles and authorized maintenance employees are permitted to work on fields.
- Tampering with lighting or other County-owned equipment is prohibited.
- Any group misusing the fields, causing public disturbance or harassing staff will be suspended from any further play on County facilities and all fees will be forfeited.
- During any tournament play field maintenance crews must be given clear access to fields to carry out their duties. Players must leave the playing area. Failure to do so could mean loss of field privileges.
- Site rules and guidelines are subject to review and approval by the General Manager as needed to appropriately maintain and operate soccer complex.

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
