BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated May 8, 2012 (agenda item 3.20) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of traffic signal, lighting, and associated improvements at the intersection of Magnolia Avenue and Neece Street in the community of Home Gardens.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the specifications and special provisions. Bidders are required to acknowledge the addendum on their Contractor's Proposal, and to take the addendum into account, to be considered for award. The addendum was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addendum is attached as Addendum No. 1.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, May 23, 2012. Four bids were received. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid for all schedules of work. The lowest responsive bid was submitted by Hillcrest Contracting in the amount of \$462,288.50. The bid is \$17,134 (3.6%) less than the Engineer's Estimate.

The proposed traffic signal will improve safety by providing protected traffic movements and pedestrian crossings. This intersection is a known pedestrian path for going to and from the Home Gardens Library and adjacent bus stops. This intersection is also next to Home Gardens Fire Station #13.

The proposed project improvements require acquisition of property in the median of Magnolia Avenue to accommodate the left-turn lanes. The Magnolia Avenue median area is owned by Union Pacific Railroad Company (UP). The County initiated the eminent domain process in May 2011 and the County was granted possession of UP's ROW on March 27, 2012 during a pre-judgment hearing. The land value remains to be determined in court or through negotiations between the parties, which are on-going.

The proposed work will be funded by State Proposition 1B Local Partnership Program (SLPP) funds and West County DIF Signal Mitigation funds. The project was awarded the SLPP funds in October 2009 through a competitive process in which the County was successful. Allocation of the SLPP funds by the California Transportation Commission (CTC) occurred on October 28, 2011.

The bid documents include the following schedules of work:

- Base Bid: Primary items of work on Magnolia Avenue and Neece Street.
- Alternate 1: Relocation of Fire Hydrant, to be funded by the Home Gardens County Water District (HGCWD).

The work included in Alternate bid schedule 1 is recommended for award. The costs for the work will be funded by HGCWD.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 for this location. The County share is 75% (\$4,125) because the southwest corner of the intersection is in the City of Corona, to be funded from gas tax.

The Contractor will be requested to execute the contract and provide bonds and insurance documents after the Board approval.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **HILLCREST CONTRACTING, INC.** hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

RECITALS:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Magnolia Avenue and Neece Street, Traffic Signal and Street Improvement, Project No. B6-0460**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

AGREEMENT:

IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Contract Documents. The entire contract consists of the following: (a) The Agreement. (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders. (d) The Contractor's Proposal. (e) The Bid Bond. (f) The Payment Bond. (g) The Performance Bond. (h) The General Conditions. (i) The Special Provisions. (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents. (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions. (l) The Plans. (m) Addenda No. **(One)**. (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work. (o) Any Change Orders issued. (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Agreement and the Payment Bond and Faithful Performance Bond.
2. The Work. Contractor shall do all things necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion. Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07, "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall begin work within 15 days of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of his intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start. If the project has more than one location of work, a separate notice shall be given for each location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by him in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by him at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- (1) The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- (2) All work done according to the contract prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- (3) The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation. Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

Fire hydrant relocation/adjustment to grade shall conform to the plans and Standard Specifications of the Western Municipal Water District (WMWD) and as directed by the Engineer. The Contractor shall furnish and install CAT6 cable and complete connections between Ethernet Switch and installed equipment in controller cabinet including traffic signal controller, Battery Backup System & video detection system encoder and other Ethernet devices in cabinets at locations shown on the plans or directed by the Engineer.

Contractor shall furnish and install CAT6 cable in communication hubs and complete connections between Aggregation Switch and installed equipment in rack, at locations as shown on the plans.

Installation

The Ethernet Switches and Ethernet over Twisted Pair Switches shall be furnished and installed by the contractor. All Ethernet hardware will be configured by the manufacturer prior to installation by Contractor.

The Ethernet switches, Ethernet over Twisted Pair Switches and power supplies shall be DIN rail mounted on the inside wall of the traffic signal controller cabinet or as directed by Engineer. Contractor shall furnish and install DIN rail as required for mounting.
