The 2013-2014 One Year Action Plan of the 2009-2014 Consolidated Plan includes the unincorporated areas of the County (including the city of Jurupa Valley) and the following Cooperating Cities: Banning, Beaumont, Blythe, Coachella, Canyon Lake, Desert Hot Springs, Indian Wells, Lake Elsinore, La Quinta, Murrieta, Norco, San Jacinto, and Wildomar.

IMPLEMENTATION. The goals for the 2013-2014 One Year Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan include: creating affordable housing for those of very low, low, and moderate-income; providing home ownership opportunities for first-time buyers; improving conditions of sub-standard housing and rental housing; addressing farm worker housing needs; ensuring the availability of emergency shelters to address the needs of the homeless.

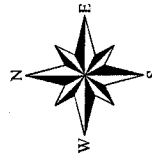
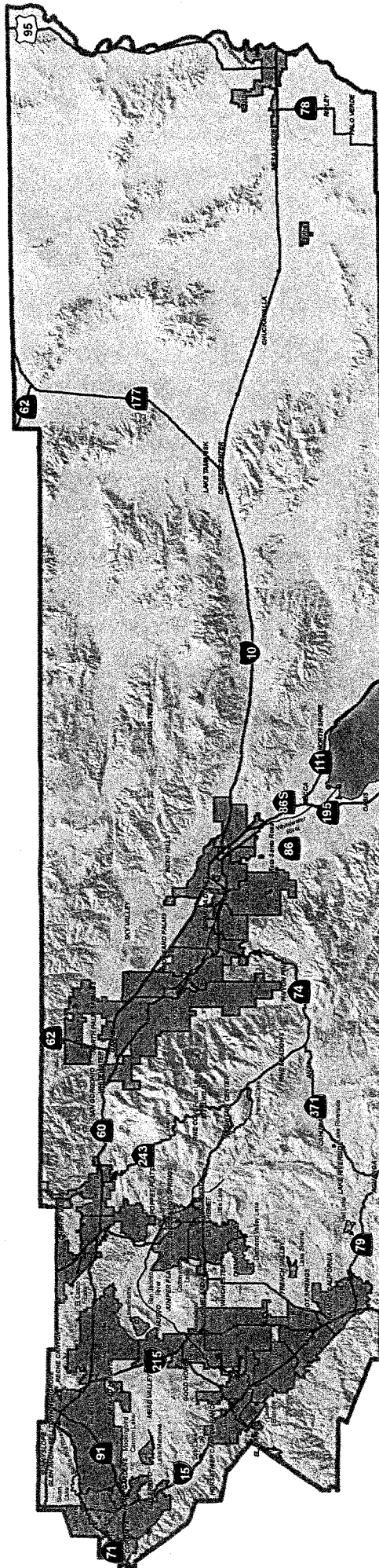
