RESOLUTION NO. 2013-002

AMENDING THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 81000, et seq., requires that state and local government agencies adopt and promulgate Conflict of Interest Codes; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, i.e., 2 California Code of Regulations, section 18730, which contains the terms of a Standard Conflict of Interest Code, which may be incorporated by reference, and which may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, on May 24, 2005, adopted the provisions of 2 California Code of Regulations, section 18730 and any amendments to it as adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission with an Appendix in which certain enumerated officials and employees and members of certain enumerated Boards, Commissions, Committees and the Grand Jury are designated and disclosure categories to constitute the Conflict of Interest Code for Departments, Agencies, and Bodies of the County of Riverside; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors on March 1, 2011, amended the Appendix of the County's Conflict of Interest; and

WHEREAS, as changed circumstances within the County have made it advisable and necessary pursuant to Section 87306 and 87307 of the Political Reform Act to amend and update the Appendix of the County's Conflict of Interest; and

WHEREAS, notice of time and place of a public hearing on, and of consideration by the Board of Supervisors of, the proposed amended Appendix was publicly posted for review at 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, and duly published in a newspaper of general circulation in the County for a period of two weeks; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amended Conflict of Interest Code was considered at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors on January 8, 2013, at which all present were given an opportunity to be heard on the proposed adoption of the amended Conflict of Interest Code; NOW,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all designated employees shall file their Statements of Economic Interest with the Head of their Department or Agency. Upon receipt of the Statements of Economic Interest, the Head of the Department or Agency shall retain the Statements on file with their office, with the exception of the Statement of the Department or Agency Head who shall file his or her own Statement with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Consultants, Members of Boards, Commissions, Committees and members of the Grand Jury shall file their statements directly with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Statements shall be filed by April 1 of each year to reflect interests held in the prior calendar year.

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CATEGORY 5: All investments and business positions in, and sources of income (including gifts, loans and travel payments) from, business entities that provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment of a type purchased or leased by the County of Riverside.

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CATEGORY 6: All investments and business positions in, and sources of income (including gifts, loans and travel payments) from, business entitles that provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment of a type used or administered or proposed to be acquired by, leased by, used by or administered by the designated employee's department or reviewed, commented upon or recommended by the designated member's Board, Commission, Committee or Council.

Since 1986, the County has been using the standard Conflict of Interest Code found in California Code of regulations, Title 2, Section 18730. Government Code Section 87306.5 requires that in every even year, all local agencies review their codes and make any appropriate amendments to their Conflict of Interest Codes, and the listing of designated positions for employees who must disclose along with the types of disclosure required. The county is considered a local agency under Government Code Section 82041.

The proposed amendment revises and updates the Appendix to the County's Conflict of Interest Code. The Appendix lists the designated positions and the disclosure categories.

The Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) requires that a public hearing be set for amendments to the County's Conflict of Interest Code and recommends a 45-day comment period. Following the 45-day comment period, the public hearing will occur, at which time the Board of Supervisors may adopt the Conflict of Interest Code.

It is recommended that Department Heads provide a signed certificate each year that the employees in their department or agency, whose positions are listed in the code, have timely completed and turned in their 700 Disclosure Forms.


