Raised in the La Sierra area of Riverside, John briefly served as an Army medic and taught English to fourth and sixth grade students in Rialto for over 30 years. After a rare physical condition led to his paralysis in 1983, he was left with no movement or sensation below his chest. In 1989, he married his wife Lynne and found encouragement to get back out into the world and make a difference. As an instrumental force in the disability rights community working with various groups including Californians for Disability Rights, his determined fight to increase access for the disabled led the city to fix nearly 200 curbs and sidewalks.

John was a loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, and friend whose memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved him. He will be dearly missed.

On motion of Supervisor Tavaglione, seconded by Supervisor Benoit, and duly carried by unanimous vote, IT WAS ORDERED that the meeting of Tuesday, January 8, 2013, be adjourned in memory of John Quimby, a 77-year-old former Inland lawmaker and lobbyist who after a courageous battle with chronic pulmonary disease, succumbed to his declining health on December 22, 2012.

Overcoming childhood polio and alcoholism, John was a "good, decent guy who always wanted to help people." Having a "deep, loud" voice, John got his start in radio and, at age 22, he became the youngest member elected to the San Bernardino City Council. After serving from 1959 to 1962, he ran for the then-72nd Assembly District and spent a dozen years in the Assembly. He also authored the 1965 law which bears his name requiring developers to set aside park land, provide conservation easements, and pay fees to improve parks.

John was a loving father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, and friend whose memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved him. He will be dearly missed.
