3. Award the contract to Sequel Contractors, Inc. and authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to execute the contract documents.
4. Adopt the attached Resolution No. 2013-021 in accordance with the provisions of the Section 57384 (c) of the Government Code.

BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated October 02, 2012 (Agenda Item 3.26), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Traffic Signal modification and roadway widening at the intersection of Limonite Avenue and Etiwanda Avenue, in the City of Jurupa Valley, additionally, the specifications and plans were approved by that Board of Supervisors action.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the specifications and special provisions. Bidders are required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their Contractor's Proposal in order to be considered for award. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, October 31, 2012. Eight bids were received, ranging from \$758,453 to \$1,599,521. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Sequel Contractors, Inc. of Santa Fe Springs, CA in the amount of \$758,453, which is \$222,647 (22.7%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

Grant funds were approved, the project was budgeted and construction drawings were substantially prepared prior to incorporation of the City of Jurupa Valley. The City of Jurupa Valley has informed the Transportation Department that the City desires the County to continue as lead agency through project completion and they have approved the construction drawings. The City of Jurupa Valley will maintain the signal after completion.

The proposed improvements will increase traffic capacity by adding left turn lanes on Rubidoux Boulevard and improve traffic safety. In addition to the new signal installation, the proposed improvements include reconstructing a 0.3 mile segment of Rubidoux Boulevard. Additional work includes placement of curb and gutter, pavement markers, roadside signs, installing painted traffic stripes and thermoplastic crosswalks and pavement markings and any other work as may be required.

Funding for construction of these improvements is being provided, in part, from Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program funds for which the County successfully competed.

In addition, the Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

The project is expected to be completed within the existing budget as shown on Attachment A.

WHEREAS, City staff at August 30, 2102 meeting has confirmed the City's desire to work with County to move forward with Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside assembled in regular session on January 15, 2013 that the County hereby agrees to complete the Project at an estimated full cost of One million Two Hundred Eighteen Thousand Six hundred Seventy-Nine (\$1,218,679), for which the City will not participate.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and concluded in duplicate as of the date set forth below, between the County of Riverside, party of the first part, and Sequel Contractors, Inc., Contractor, party of the second part.

ARTICLE I: WITNESSETH, that for and in consideration of the payments and agreements hereinafter mentioned, to be made and performed by the said party of the first part, and under the conditions expressed in the two bonds, bearing even date with these presents, the said party of the second part agrees with the said party of the first part, at his own proper cost and expense, to do all the work and furnish all the materials, except such as are mentioned in the specifications to be furnished by said party of the first part, necessary to construct and complete in a good, workmanlike and substantial manner and to the satisfaction of the County of Riverside, in accordance with the Special Provisions, "Notice to Contractors", the State of California Department of Industrial Relations Wage Determination, the Federal Wage Determination, the Proposal to the County of Riverside for the Project, addendum No. 1 and 2, the Bid Bond, the Performance Bond, the Payment Bond, any specific plans for the project not covered by the Standard Specifications and Standard Plans, any change orders issued, and any written instructions and drawings executed and delivered to the Contractor by the County pursuant to the Contract Documents. Also in accordance with the Standard Plans and the Standard Specifications dated May 2006, the General Prevailing Wage Rates of the Department of Transportation, with the effective date being the date of advertisement, and the Labor Surcharge and Equipment Rental Rates, with the effective date being the date of advertisement, and the Labor Surcharge and Equipment Rental Rates, with the effective date being the date of accomplishing the work, which said special provisions Standard Plans, Standard Specifications, Prevailing Wage Rates, and Labor Surcharge and Equipment Rental Rates are hereby specially referred to and by such reference, made a part hereof.

The work to be done is shown on plans entitled City of Jurupa Valley, Rubidoux Boulevard & 28th Street, Traffic Signal. Project Sheets 1 through 4, approved April 4, 2012 on file with the County Surveyor file No.956-YY, and as revised by addenda, which said project plans are hereby made a part of this contract.

ARTICLE II: The said party of the first part hereby promises and agrees with the said Contractor to employ, and does hereby employ, the said Contractor to provide the materials and to do the work according to the terms and conditions herein contained and referred to, for the prices hereinafter set forth, and hereby contracts to pay the same at the time, in the manner and upon the conditions herein set forth; and the said parties for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, do hereby agree to the full performance of the covenants herein contained.

ARTICLE III: The statement of prevailing wages appearing in the General Prevailing Wage Rates is hereby specifically referred to and by this reference is made a part of this contract. It is further expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that should there be any conflict between the terms of this instrument and the bid or proposal of said Contractor, then this instrument shall control and nothing herein shall be considered as an acceptance of the said terms of said proposal conflicting herewith.

ARTICLE IV: By my signature hereunder, as Contractor, I certify that I am aware of the provisions of Section 3700 of the Labor Code which require every employer to be insured against liability for workmen's compensation or to undertake self-insurance in accordance with the provisions of that code and I will comply with such provisions before commencing the performance of the work of this contract.

ARTICLE V: And the said Contractor agrees to receive and accept the following prices as full compensation for furnishing all materials and for doing all the work contemplated and embraced in this agreement; also for all loss or damage, arising out of the nature of the work aforesaid, or from the action of the elements, or from any unforeseen difficulties or obstructions which may arise or be encountered in the prosecution of the work until its acceptance by the County of Riverside, and for all risks of every description connected with the work; also for all expenses incurred by or in consequence of the suspension or discontinuance of work and for well and faithfully completing the work, and the whole thereof, in the manner and according to the plans and specifications, and the requirements of the Engineer under them, to wit:

SECTION 6

6-1 ADDITIONAL FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS:

FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR FEDERAL-AID CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

GENERAL.—The work herein proposed will be financed in whole or in part with Federal funds, and therefore all of the statutes, rules and regulations promulgated by the Federal Government and applicable to work financed in whole or in part with Federal funds will apply to such work. The "Required Contract Provisions, Federal-Aid Construction Contracts, "Form FHWA 1273, are included in this Section. Whenever in said required contract provisions references are made to "SHA contracting officer", "SHA resident engineer", or "authorized representative of the SHA", such references shall be construed to mean "Engineer" as defined in Section 1-1.18 of the Standard Specifications.

PERFORMANCE OF PREVIOUS CONTRACT.—In addition to the provisions in Section II, "Nondiscrimination," and Section VI, "Subletting or Assigning the Contract," of the required contract provisions, the Contractor shall comply with the following:

The bidder shall execute the CERTIFICATION WITH REGARD TO THE PERFORMANCE OF PREVIOUS CONTRACTS OR SUBCONTRACTS SUBJECT TO THE EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CLAUSE AND THE FILING OF REQUIRED REPORTS located in the proposal. No request for subletting or assigning any portion of the contract in excess of \$10,000 will be considered under the provisions of Section VI of the required contract provisions unless such request is accompanied by the CERTIFICATION referred to above, executed by the proposed subcontractor.

NON-COLLUSION PROVISION.—The provisions in this section are applicable to all contracts except contracts for Federal Aid Secondary projects.

Title 23, United States Code, Section 112, requires as a condition precedent to approval by the Federal Highway Administrator of the contract for this work that each bidder file a sworn statement executed by, or on behalf of, the person, firm, association, or corporation to whom such contract is to be awarded, certifying that such person, firm, association, or corporation has not, either directly or indirectly, entered into any agreement, participated in any collusion, or otherwise taken any action in restraint of free competitive bidding in connection with the submitted bid. 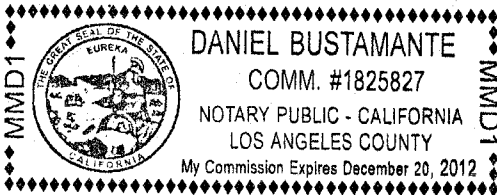

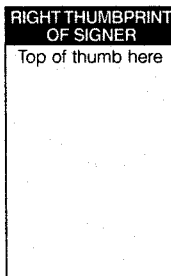

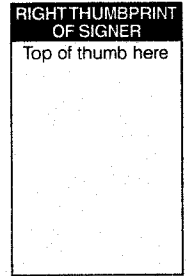
