



Background (continued):

subjects that engage the Office of County Counsel as legal advisor and primary civil litigator for the county. All county officers and employees receive the services of the County Counsel. County Counsel is funded through a combination of general funds and direct billing.

The Office of County Counsel has kept rates level since FY 2010-2011. County Counsel has no ability to absorb any increased costs, except through full cost recovery in our billable rate. In order to absorb the FY 2012/13 operating costs we must raise rates. Our rates are also used to bill against Deposit Based Fees and some external non-county agencies, such as Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO), Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP), First Five, School Districts, Riverside County Habitat Conservation Agency (RCHCA) and Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) and other direct bill clients with outside funding sources.

The recommended action requests that the Board approve County Counsel's proposed hourly billable rates for FY 2013-2014.
