

BACKGROUND:

The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that all substantial amendments to the Five-Year Consolidated Plan and the One-Year Action Plan be approved by the Board of Supervisors. All new activities added to the One-Year Action Plan, as well as a significant increase in funding to an existing project or changes to the scope of nature of an existing project, will be considered substantial amendments.

Pursuant to 24 CFR 91.105, the Economic Development Agency published a 30-day public notice notifying the public of the proposed amendment to the County of Riverside 2012-2013 One-Year Action Plan and the 2009-2014 Five-Year Consolidated Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment B. Staff recommends approval of the HOME projects as described in Attachment A.

Amendment Action:

The County of Riverside 2012-2013 One-Year Action Plan of the 2009-2014 Five-Year Consolidated Plan is amended as follows:

- 1. "Perris Family Apartments" and "Orange Blossom Apartments" are added to the HOME program list of funded activities;
- 2. "Summerhouse Apartments" and "Cimarron Heights at Dream Homes Apartments" are canceled and removed from the HOME program list of funded activities; and
- 3. The County of Riverside 2012-2013 One-Year Action Plan is hereby amended to allow for an added allocation of HOME funds for each project towards direct project staffing in an amount not exceed 10% of the total HOME funds approved for each project.
