## **BACKGROUND: (continued)**

The Super K Tractor will be used to assist with highly technical rescue classes at the Ben Clark Training Center such as, Rescue Systems 1 & 2, Confined Space and Trench Rescue training. It will assist with other classes as needed. In the past, we partnered with the Water District for these types of trainings.

The maintenance costs for this type of equipment are estimated to be \$4,000 annually. This cost will be covered by the Department not having to rent this type of equipment for training in the future; therefore, no additional costs will be realized by the Department.
