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BACKGROUND

On January 26, 2011, County Purchasing released on its website and to vendors on a bidders list, Request for Proposal (RFP) No. DPARC-192, soliciting bids from qualified vendors to provide Kinship Support Services to Relative Caregivers and the Children placed in their homes. Three proposals were received in response to the RFP from Community Access Network, California Family Life Center, and Family Services of the Desert. All proposals were screened and deemed responsive. After careful review and consideration by the proposal evaluation team, It was determined that California Family Life Center (CFLC) was the most responsive.

The original funding allocation for the Kinship Support Services Program (KSSP) was distributed between DPSS and CFLC, to provide kinship support services to the Children Services population. On October 25, 2011, County Purchasing approved the Professional Services Agreement with CFLC, to provide Kinship Support Services in the amount of \$90,000 for fiscal year July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012 with two (2) additional one-year renewal options.

Due to the attrition of Social Workers over the past three (3) years, CSD realized savings in CWS Basic funding freeing up additional KSSP funding. To this end, CSD is requesting to shift the additional available KSSP funds in the amount of \$130,000.00 and DPSS' share of Kincare services to CFLC. Shifting the funds/services to CFLC leverages the funding through close monitored case management services, and reduces the additional cost for open court cases for legal guardianship thus yielding additional savings to DPSS.

CFLC provides community-based family support services to relative caregivers and the children placed in their homes. Their services include: responding to referrals from the Children's Services Division Investigative Services and Legal Guardianship Units to provide aftercare support to families that are entering legal guardianship to prevent Juvenile Court involvement; assisting with the completion of court documents; parenting education: kinship support groups: counseling and referral services aimed at promoting permanency, including kinship adoption and guardianship; individual and group counseling in the areas of parent/child relationships and conflict resolution; childcare; respite care services; and tutoring and homework assistance.

FINANCIAL:

The additional funding is 100% realignment funding, and therefore there is no fiscal impact to the county.
