SUBJECT: Increase Number of Trustees on Palo Verde Valley Library District Board

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Adopt Resolution No. 2013-085 directing the Clerk of the Board to set and notice a public hearing for April 23, 2013, on the matter of increasing from three (3) to five (5) the number of seats on the Palo Verde Valley Library District Board of Trustees; and
- 2. At the conclusion of the public hearing:
  - a. Adopt Resolution No. 2013-086 increasing the number of trustees on the Palo Verde Valley Library District Board from three (3) to five (5) and setting the expiration dates of their terms of office; and
  - b. Appoint the following two additional members of the Palo Verde Valley Library District Board of Trustees:
    - (1) Rosemary Covino Marlowe, whose term will expire on the last Friday in November of 2013; and
    - (2) Sally Jo Martin-Rodriguez, whose term will expire on the last Friday in November of 2015.

**BACKGROUND:** Since the Palo Verde Valley Library District was first established in 1958, the Board of Trustees has had three members. On March 20, 2012, the Board of Trustees of the Palo Verde Valley Library District approved the increase in the number of members from three to five and directed that the Board of Trustees' resolution approving the increase be filed with the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Education Code section 19431, subdivision (b).

There is a community of interest in support of the increase in the number of members serving on the Board of Trustees. The increase in Board of Trustee members will also assist in ensuring a quorum is available to meet and conduct the necessary business of the Palo Verde Valley Library District.

The terms for the Board of Trustees are staggered under state law. For five member boards, two members are required to have terms that expire on the last Friday in November of 2013, and three members are required to have terms that expire on the last Friday in November of 2015 (Education Code section 19432(b)). Currently, Trustee Joyce Anderson serves until her term expires in 2013 and Floie Barrows and Dale Otake serve until their terms expire in 2015. The increase in Board members will result in one additional member serving until the last Friday in November 2013 and one additional member serving until the last Friday in November of 2015.

If the Board of Trustees is increased from three to five members, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint the two additional trustees from the Palo Verde Valley Library District at large in accordance with Education Code section 19432, subdivision (b).

I recommend that the Board of Supervisors appoint Ms. Rosemary Marlowe to the Palo Verde Valley Library District Board of Trustees. As a retired teacher with a Master's Degree in History, Ms. Marlowe is an advocate for education and passionate about expanding the availability of books to residents in the Palo Verde Valley. Ms. Marlowe would be an excellent addition to the Board of Trustees.

I also recommend that the Board of Supervisors appoint Ms. Sally Jo Martin-Rodriguez to the Palo Verde Valley Library District Board of Trustees. Ms. Martin-Rodriguez currently serves as the Chief Nurse Executive for the Department of Corrections in Blythe and would like to be appointed to the Palo Verde Valley Library District Board of Trustees. Ms. Martin-Rodriguez is a strong supporter of the library. She previously served on the Riverside Library Board of Trustees and would like to utilize her experience to bring new ideas to benefit the community with enhanced access to the library. I strongly recommend Ms. Martin-Rodriguez for the Palo Verde Valley Library District Board of Trustees.

WHEREAS, a copy of the Board of Trustees Resolution 2012-01 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, at its option, may conduct a public hearing on a resolution filed pursuant to section 19431, in accordance with Education Code section 19432(a).

WHEREAS, there is a community of interest in support of the increase in the number of members serving on the Board of Trustees. The increase in Board of Trustee members will also assist in ensuring a quorum is available to meet and conduct the necessary business of the Palo Verde Valley Library District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside assembled in regular session on March 26, 2013 that a public hearing be scheduled for April 23, 2013.
