ORDINANCE NO. 729
(AS AMENDED THROUGH 729.6) AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE ESTABLISHING FEES, CHARGES AND RATES FOR ASSESSOR, COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER SERVICES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, ordains as follows:

Section 1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

A. PURPOSE. The purpose of this section is to establish fees in reasonable amounts to cover the costs of rendering certain enumerated services and supplies furnished by the Assessor-County Clerk-Recorder's Office.

B. AUTHORITY. The authority for the fees established herein is found in Government Code Sections 6157, 6253, 8201.1, 8213, 12194, 26831, 26836, 26840, 26840.1, 26840.2, 26840.3, 26840.7, 26840.8, 26849.1, 26850, 26851, 26852, 26855, 26855.1, 26855.2, 26855.3, 26861, 27293, 27361, 27361.9, 27364, 27366, 27372, 27387, 27397, 27585, 54985, 54986, 65092; Business and Professional Code 6404, 6405, 17926, 17929, 22352, 22353, 22453, 22455, 22457, 27366; Civil Code 3097; Corporations Code 14502; Family Code 360, 401, 506, 536, 1852; Fish and Game Code 711.4; Health & Safety 100430, 103525.5, 103625; Penal Code 14251; Welfare and Institutions Code 18966.

Section 2. SEVERABILITY. Should any fee herein established be held to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of all remaining fee provisions.

Section 3. LISTING NOT COMPREHENSIVE. This Ordinance is not intended to contain all fees that are or may be charged by the Assessor-County Clerk-Recorder for services and supplies and to the extent that other fees are customarily charged or are established elsewhere and are not listed below, all such fees, charges, and rates shall remain in full force and effect.

ORDINANCE NO. 735

(AS AMENDED THROUGH 735.2) AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE 735 ESTABLISHING FEES FOR THE SEPARATE ASSESSMENT (TIMESHARE) PROJECTS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, ordains as follows: Section 1. Purpose and Authority. This ordinance adopts and establishes fees for the separate assessment of timeshare projects as provided Revenue and Taxation Code sections 2188.8 and 2188.9.

Section 2. Application. The fees set out herein charges for the initial and the ongoing costs of separate assessment and billing and mailings v respect to timeshare projects made in accordance with Revenue and Taxation Code sections 218 and 2188.9. This ordinance is intended to be applicable to assessments on the 1993-94 assessment roll and subsequent assessment rolls.

Section 3. Fees. The following fees shall be charged for each timeshare project separate assessment made by the County Assessor under Revenue and Taxation Code sections 2188.8 and 2188.9:

1. Separate Timeshare Assessments (New: \$20.82 up)

2. Separate Timeshare Assessments (Ongoing Maintenance) \$20.82

Section 4. Levy and Collection. For the 1993-94 assessment roll, the timeshare separate assessments that are subject to the provisions of this ordinance, and which are to be added to the assessed assessments by the County Auditor-Controller, are as set out on the report of County Assessor accompanying the notice of public hearing given in consideration of the adoption of this ordinance. For assessment rolls subsequent to 1993-94, the County Assessor shall submit a report identifying each timeshare project which separate assessments that are subject to the fees established herein have been made by the Board of Supervisors at a regular meeting of the Board on or before August 1st of each year. On receipt and filing of the report, the County Auditor-Controller shall levy the indicated fees on the assessment numbers as reported to the Assessor. For 1993-94 and years thereafter the fees shall be billed and collected along with the regular taxes and assessments related to the timeshare project separate assessment and shall be subject to the same delinquency penalties, interest otherwise applicable to the regular assessments. When collected, the fees and assessments shall be deposited into the County general fund.

Section 5. Severability. If any clause, provision, sentence, or paragraph of this ordinance, or application thereof, is deemed to be invalid or inoperative, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance which shall still have full force and effect, and, to this end, it is hereby declared that the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 831
(AS AMENDED THROUGH 831.2) AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE ESTABLISHING ASSESSOR FEES FOR UNDEVELOPED INTERESTS AND SEPARATE VALUATION. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. This Ordinance adopts and establishes fees authorized by law, in the reasonably necessary to recover the cost incurred by the County Assessor in providing the services enumerated herein.

Section 2. Authority. The authority for the fees established herein is found in the California Revenue and Taxation Code, Sections 2802, 2821, 4151 and Government Code Sections 5491 and 5492.

Section 3. Severability. Should any fee established be held to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining fee provision.

Section 4. Fees. The Assessor shall collect the following fees for the services or product rendered:
