SUBJECT: Acceptance of the FY 2012-13 Automobile Insurance Fraud Program Grant Award and budget adjustment.

## **RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve and ratify acceptance of the Automobile Insurance Fraud Program Grant ("AIF") award from the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California Department of Insurance in the amount of \$650,000 for the grant period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.
- 2. Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to adjust the budget as specified on schedule A to bring originally projected AIF revenue to the award amount of \$650,000.

BACKGROUND: The Insurance Commissioner of the State of California has renewed the Automobile Insurance Fraud Program grant for the July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 grant period. The grant, awarded under the provision of Section 1872.8 of the California Insurance Code, is to be used by the District Attorney solely for the purpose of enhanced investigation and prosecution of automobile insurance fraud cases. The grant award is included in the department's current fiscal year budget. The attached grant award and resolution have been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.
