BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated January 15, 2013 (Agenda Item 3.14), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Ontario Avenue/Temescal Canyon Road and El Cerrito Road/Minnesota Road in the El Cerrito community. Additionally, the specifications and plans were approved by that Board of Supervisors action.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the specifications and special provisions. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their Contractor's Proposal. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, February 6, 2013. Six bids were received, ranging from \$522,946 to \$732,337. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Superior Paving Company, Inc. dba United Paving Company of La Mirada, CA in the amount of \$522,946, which is \$596 (0.11%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety and operation. This intersection is a pedestrian path for going to and from the El Cerrito Middle School, Library, Sports Park, and adjacent bus stops. Additionally, the project will include installation of signing and striping, a new raised median with colored stamped concrete, new ADA compliant curb ramps, construction of driveway approaches, curb and gutter, sidewalk, bus stop pad, pavement reconstruction, installation of a new asphalt parking lot, and a waste water treatment system on private property, which is mitigation due to impacts on the property caused by the project.

The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

The contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid and has executed the contract and provided bonds and isurance documents, which meet the requirements of the contract.

- 2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Contract Documents. The entire contract consists of the following: (a) The Agreement. (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders. (d) The Contractor's Proposal. (e) The Bid Bond. (f) The Payment Bond. (g) The Performance Bond. (h) The General Conditions. (i) The Special Provisions. (i) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents. (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions. (I) The Plans. (m) Addenda No. one and two. (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work. (o) Any (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, Change Orders issued. instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Agreement and the Payment Bond and Faithful Performance Bond.
- 2. <u>The Work.</u> Contractor shall do all things necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. <u>Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion</u>. Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07, "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall begin work within 15 days of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of his intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start. If the project has more than one location of work, a separate notice shall be given for each location

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by him in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by him at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- (1) The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- (2) All work done according to the contract prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- (3) The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".
- 4. <u>Compensation</u>. Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.



Item 2: Equipment Orders

Refer to sub-section "Equipment Orders" on page 94. Delete the second and third paragraphs of "Equipment Orders" sub-section and replace with the following special provisions:

Submittals and issuance of Notice to Proceed

Within twenty one (21) calendar days after the award of the contract, the Contractor shall submit equipment and materials submittals to the Engineer for review and approval. The Contractor shall allow fourteen (14) calendar days for the Engineer to review the equipment and materials submittals. If revisions are required as determined by the Engineer, the Contractor shall revise and resubmit the equipment and materials submittals within seven (7) calendar days of receipt of the Engineer's comments and shall allow seven (7) working days for the Engineer to review the revisions. Once the submittals are approved by the Engineer, the Contractor must order equipment and materials and then submit a copy of each vendor Equipment and Material Purchase Order within (7) calendar days to the Engineer.

The Contractor must have copies of approved Equipment and Material submittal(s) and Purchase Order(s) prior to the coordination and issuance of the Notice to Proceed. Delay in equipment delivery shall not be considered as justification for the suspension of the construction contract.

Additional Liquidated Damages

In addition to the liquidated damages set forth in Special Provision section "Liquidated Damages" of these contract documents, the Contractor shall pay to the County of Riverside the sum of \$800.00 per day for each and every calendar day delay in receiving all of the below listed equipment furnished by the Contractor, onto the job site or the Contractor's storage facility, and available for installation, within sixty (60) calendar days of the contract award date:

- 1. Traffic Signal Controller Assemblies
- 2. Service Equipment Enclosures
- 3. Traffic Signal and Pedestrian Signal Heads
- 4. LED Modules
- 5. Edge-Lit Internally Illuminated Street Name Signs and Mounting Brackets

The Contractor shall furnish a spared VCD, a spare FM, and a spare VDP to the Engineer.



Requests to Address Board on "Agenda" Items:

You may request to be heard on a published agenda item. Requests to be heard must be submitted to the Clerk of the Board before the scheduled meeting time.

Requests to Address Board on items that are "NOT" on the Agenda:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these rules, member of the public shall have the right to address the Board during the mid-morning "Oral Communications" segment of the published agenda. Said purpose for address must pertain to issues which are under the direct jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors. YOUR TIME WILL BE LIMITED TO THREE (3) MINUTES.

Power Point Presentations/Printed Material:

Speakers who intend to conduct a formalized Power Point presentation or provide printed material must notify the Clerk of the Board's Office by 12 noon on the Monday preceding the Tuesday Board meeting, insuring that the Clerk's Office has sufficient copies of all printed materials and at least one (1) copy of the Power Point CD. Copies of printed material given to the Clerk (by Monday noon deadline) will be provided to each Supervisor. If you have the need to use the overhead "Elmo" projector at the Board meeting, please insure your material is clear and with proper contrast, notifying the Clerk well ahead of the meeting, of your intent to use the Elmo.

Individual Speaker Limits:

Individual speakers are limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes. Please step up to the podium when the Chairman calls your name and begin speaking immediately. Pull the microphone to your mouth so that the Board, audience, and audio recording system hear you clearly. Once you start speaking, the "green" podium light will light. The "yellow" light will come on when you have one (1) minute remaining. When you have 30 seconds remaining, the "yellow" light will begin flash, indicating you must quickly wrap up your comments.
