3. Award the contract to Superior Paving Company, Inc. dba United Paving Company and authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to execute the contract documents, and;
4. Approve the project's proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A".

BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated January 15, 2013 (Agenda Item 3.14), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Ontario Avenue/Temescal Canyon Road and El Cerrito Road/Minnesota Road in the El Cerrito community. Additionally, the specifications and plans were approved by that Board of Supervisors action.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the specifications and special provisions. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their Contractor's Proposal. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, February 6, 2013. Six bids were received, ranging from \$522,946 to \$732,337. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Superior Paving Company, Inc. dba United Paving Company of La Mirada, CA in the amount of \$522,946, which is \$596 (0.11%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety and operation. This intersection is a pedestrian path for going to and from the El Cerrito Middle School, Library, Sports Park, and adjacent bus stops. Additionally, the project will include installation of signing and striping, a new raised median with colored stamped concrete, new ADA compliant curb ramps, construction of driveway approaches, curb and gutter, sidewalk, bus stop pad, pavement reconstruction, installation of a new asphalt parking lot, and a waste water treatment system on private property, which is mitigation due to impacts on the property caused by the project.

The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

The contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid and has executed the contract and provided bonds and insurance documents, which meet the requirements of the contract.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **Superior Paving Company, Inc. dba United Paving Company** hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

RECITALS:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Ontario Avenue/ Temescal Canyon Road and El Cerrito Road/Minnesota Road, Construction of Traffic Signals, Parking Lot, and Associated Improvements, Project No. B7-0767**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

AGREEMENT:

IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Contract Documents. The entire contract consists of the following: (a) The Agreement. (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders. (d) The Contractor's Proposal. (e) The Bid Bond. (f) The Payment Bond. (g) The Performance Bond. (h) The General Conditions. (i) The Special Provisions. (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents. (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions. (l) The Plans. (m) Addenda No. **one and two**. (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work. (o) Any Change Orders issued. (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Agreement and the Payment Bond and Faithful Performance Bond.
2. The Work. Contractor shall do all things necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion. Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07, "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall begin work within 15 days of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of his intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start. If the project has more than one location of work, a separate notice shall be given for each location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by him in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by him at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- (1) The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
 - (2) All work done according to the contract prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
 - (3) The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".
4. Compensation. Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

Item 2: Working Days.

Refer to section "Liquidated Damages" on page 51. Delete and replace the first sentence with the following:

The Contractor shall diligently prosecute the work to completion before the expiration of 50 working days from the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed".

Item 3: Additional Liquidated Damages.

Refer to section entitled "Liquidated Damages" on page 51. The following special provision for "Liquidated Damages" is added and made part here of:

The Contractor shall complete all the improvements on Ontario Avenue/Temescal Canyon Road and El Cerrito Road/Minnesota Road prior to August 1st, 2013, with additional liquidated damages of \$5,000.00 per calendar day, for each and every calendar day's delay in finishing the work beyond August 1st, 2013.

Item 4: Order of Work, First Order of Work.

Refer to section entitled "Order of Work" on page 52. The following special provision for "Order of Work" is added and made part here of:

Prior to initiating construction activities at the intersection of Ontario Avenue and El Cerrito Road, the Contractor shall begin the improvements at the intersection of Temescal Canyon Road and Minnesota Road as the first order of work including the installation of onsite wastewater treatment system and construction of parking lot improvements on private property located at the southeast corner of the intersection.

Construction at the intersection of Ontario Avenue and El Cerrito Road shall be limited while school is in session to minimize any interference with school traffic as directed by the Engineer. The last day of school at El Cerrito Middle School adjacent to the project will be May 30, 2013 and will resume August 1st, 2013.

Item 5: Lane Closures.

Refer to sections entitled "Traffic Control System" and "Maintaining Traffic" on pages 53 through 56. The following special provision pertaining to "Lane Closures" is added and made part here of:

Construction activities at the intersections of Ontario Avenue and El Cerrito Road, and Temescal Canyon Road and Minnesota Road that will require lane closures prior to June 1st, 2013 will not be allowed.

Item 6: School Traffic Clarification.

It is anticipated that schools adjacent to the project will have hours between 7:45 a.m. and 2:10 p.m. If necessary, as directed by the Resident Engineer, the Contractor will be required to stop work before and/or after school hours to minimize any interference with school traffic.

Item 7: Crossing Guards.

The following special provision for "Crossing Guards" is added and made part here of:

The Contractor shall provide crossing guards, if determined necessary by the Resident Engineer, at school crosswalks located at the intersections of Ontario Avenue and Rudell Road, and at Ontario Avenue and El Cerrito Road when schoolchildren are normally going to or from school and at other times as may be necessary.

The Crossing Guard shall control and direct the movements of both pedestrians and vehicular traffic so as to best protect and safeguard the lives and well-being of the schoolchildren as they go to and from school.

Method of Payment:

Full compensation for implementing "Crossing Guards" shall be made on a force account basis, in accordance with Section 9-1.03 of the Standard Specifications. The total accumulated costs for Crossing Guards shall not exceed the amount specified in the contract bid item, unless otherwise increased by change order.

Delete the following circuit breaker on page 99:

- 1 – 15 Amp 1 pole (for video detection cameras)

Delete the GFCI outlet sentence on page 100 and replace it with the following:

A GFCI outlet shall be installed on the interior side of service cabinet door.

Item 9: Signal and Lighting, Video Detection, Cabling and Cable Connections.



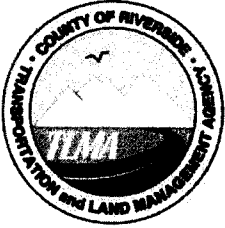

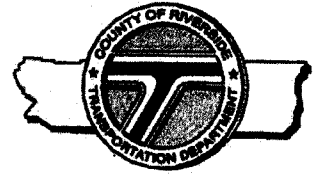

Delete the second paragraph and traffic signal equipment listed (five items); the Contractor shall note that this paragraph is also found on sub-section "Equipment Orders" on page 94 which is amended hereby on Item 2 of this Addendum No. 2. Replace the deleted paragraph on page 51 with the following paragraph:

In addition to the liquidated damages set forth above, refer to Special Provisions Section "Signal and Lighting" subsection "Equipment Orders".

Item 2: Equipment Orders

Refer to sub-section "Equipment Orders" on page 94. Delete the second and third paragraphs of "Equipment Orders" sub-section and replace with the following special provisions:

Submittals and issuance of Notice to Proceed

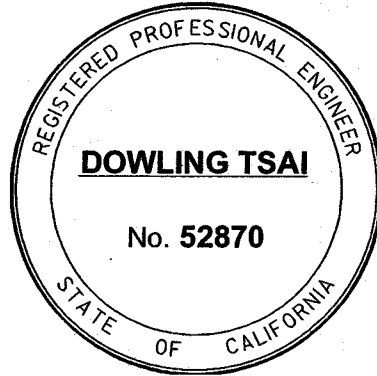

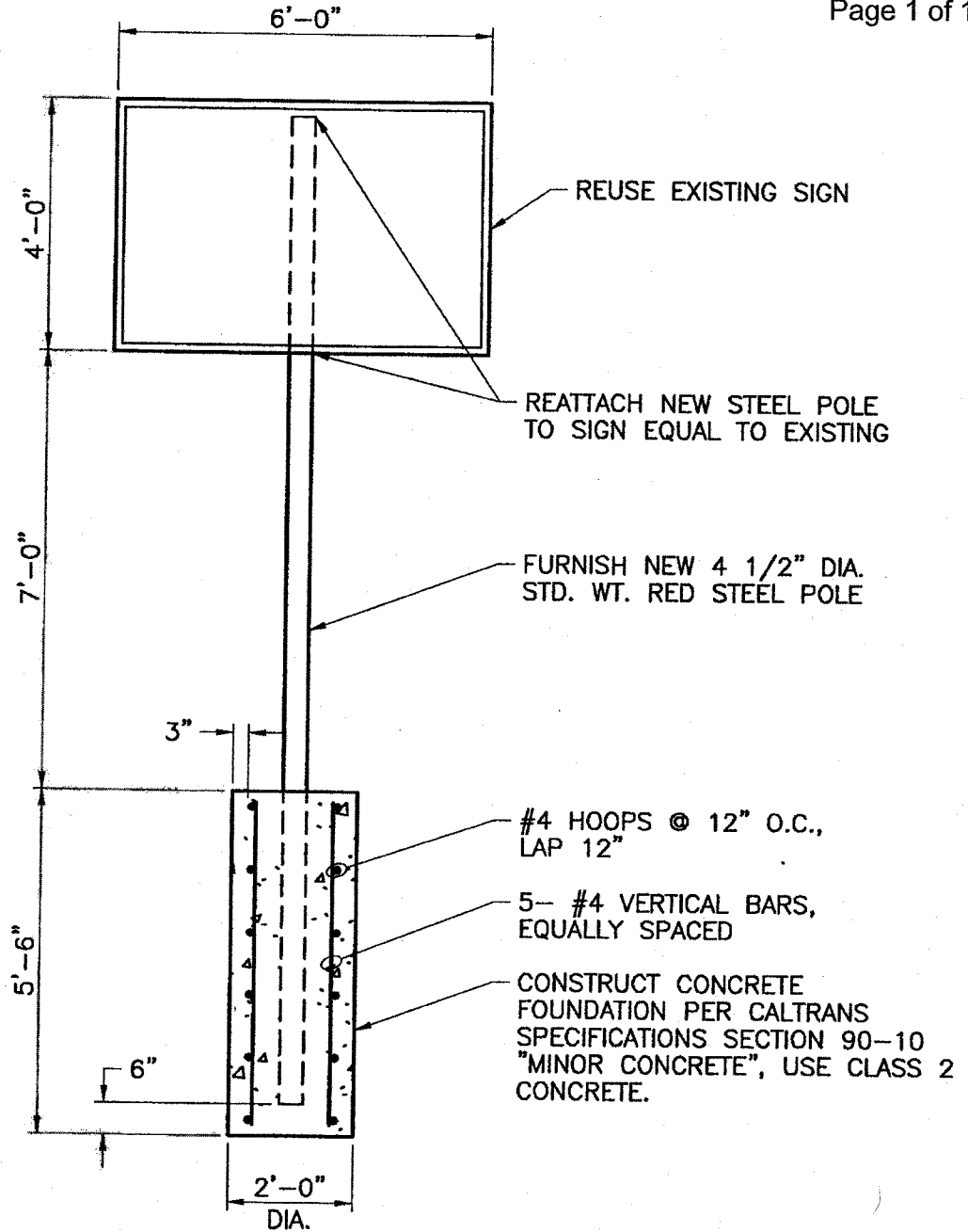
