SUBJECT: Resolution 2013-047 Authorizing the Submittal of Functional Classification Change for Local Streets and Roads within its Jurisdiction

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution 2013-047, authorizing the submittal of functional classification changes for local streets and roads within its jurisdiction as shown on the California Road System (CRS) maps.

BACKGROUND: The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) identifies functional classifications as key items in determining federal funding to build and maintain roads. Functional classifications are grouped according to the character of the service they provide in the highway network. All functionally classified roads in California appear on the CRS maps published by Caltrans. It is the responsibility of each local jurisdiction to update the maps as

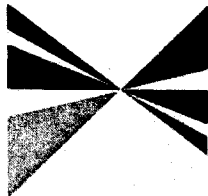
development occurs, land use changes, and roads are built and widened. A resolution by the governing body authorizing the request for changes is required. Resolution No. 2013-047 will authorize this request for change for the streets and roads described in the attachments. Inclusion in the CRS allows the County to apply for future federal dollars for improvement or maintenance of the facilities.

This submittal was initiated to address the Interstate 10 (I-10) Bypass Project, which will add a new roadway link between the communities of Cabazon and Banning, parallel to the I-10. This critical link will be built utilizing, in part, federal funds. The roadway must be functionally classified in order to qualify for federal funding.

The Transportation Department has looked at other functional classification needs in the territory spanning from Calimesa to Cabazon, known as the Pass area, specifically related to the bigger I-10 Lifeline Emergency Access Plan. Additional roadways paralleling I-10 will be considered as part of that larger plan and are being added to the CRS maps with this action. Some portions of those connections already exist, but are either under-classified as local roads or are not yet classified. Segments outside the County's jurisdiction will require updates by the appropriate agencies. The County will continue to coordinate with other agencies to ensure the roadway network is represented appropriately.

In addition to the Board's approval, the County has asked the Southern California Association of Governments for concurrence as the County's metropolitan planning organization. The completed package will be submitted to Caltrans District 8 for their concurrence and submittal to Caltrans headquarters, which will submit the request to the FHWA for approval. Once approved, the CRS maps will be updated.

Ms. Aranguiz:

SCAG has received a request from the Riverside County Transportation & Land Management Agency (TLMA) regarding the Functional Classification Change Request Form to be submitted to Caltrans (attached). Caltrans' Functional Classification Guidelines require that local agencies submit a metropolitan planning organization/regional transportation planning agency (MPO/RTPA) concurrence letter along with the Functional Classification Change Form to the Caltrans District Coordinator.

This letter serves as the concurrence from SCAG on the changes requested by the Riverside County TLMA.

The SCAG regional travel demand model includes roadway facilities from interstates (1) down to the equivalent of major collectors (5) on the FHWA's revised functional classification codes. To the extent that these changes affect the SCAG regional highway network, SCAG will update the network to reflect the changes requested by the Riverside County TLMA upon the final approval by Caltrans and the Federal Highway Administration.
