SUBJECT: Appointment to the Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:


1. Appoint Michael Wilson, Indio Mayor Pro Tem, City Representative of the Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee; and
2. Appoint Bob Botts, Banning Mayor Pro Tem, City Alternate for the Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with SB 621 (Battin and Burton), on December 16, 2003, the Board of Supervisors appointed three city and two county representatives, and one alternate in both categories, to the Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee (CBC).

John Machisic, former Banning City Council, served six years as City Alternate and Representative on the CBC. When Mr. Machisic's elected term ended in December 2012, a vacancy was created on the committee. Michael Wilson, Indio City Council, currently serves as City Alternate and is recommended to fill the City Representative vacancy. In addition, Bob Botts, Banning City Council, is being recommended to fill the Alternate post].

The role of the CBC is to allocate funds from the Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund (SDF) to local government agencies for the purpose of mitigating impacts of Tribal gaming.


