BACKGROUND continued:

Mr. Harmon has served as a criminal defense attorney in Riverside County for over 40 years and has tried over 350 jury trials, including but not limited to sexual assaults, narcotics, complex business and white collar, political corruption, and homicide/capital cases. Since 2003, Mr. Harmon has served as the Chief Administrator of Criminal Defense Lawyers (CDL). CDL is utilized by Riverside County for indigent defendants when the Public Defender's Office declares a conflict of interest in their case. As the Chief Administrator, Mr. Harmon was responsible for the management and administration of approximately 100 attorneys plus support staff, an annual budget of \$8 million, and an annual \$1 million Riverside County trust fund. Through his longstanding partnership with Riverside County, Mr. Harmon has gained a deep understanding of the function and complexities of the Office of the Public Defender.

Mr. Harmon's combination of education, broad and extensive experience, and familiarity with the Office of the Public Defender exceptionally qualify him for the Public Defender position. Based on his qualifications, HR recommends that your Board offer an annual salary of \$219,217 (Step 10 of plan/grade XAA 230) with a one-time leave credit of 40 hours, and an annual leave accrual rate of 12 hours per pay period. By approving this request, the Board of Supervisors appoints Mr. Harmon to the position of Public Defender, pursuant to Government Code Section 27700 et. seq.
