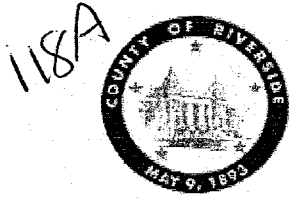



3. Award the contract to Mamco, Inc. dba AIAbbasi and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents.

BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated January 29, 2013 (Agenda Item 3.44) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Temescal Canyon Road and Dos Lagos Drive improvements, in the El Cerrito area adjacent to the City of Corona.

During the advertisement period, four addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the specifications and special provisions. Bidders are required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their Contractor's Proposal. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1, Addendum No. 2, Addendum No. 3, and Addendum No. 4.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, February 27, 2013. Eleven bids were received, ranging from \$269,000 to \$358,995. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Mamco, Inc. dba AIAbbasi of Riverside, CA in the amount of \$269,000, which is \$3,450 (1.3%) above the Engineer's Estimate. The project is expected to finish within the existing budget as shown on Attachment 'A'.

The project will widen the western half-width of Temescal Canyon Road south of Dos Lagos Drive for 650 feet. This project also includes construction of curb, gutter, standard and meandering sidewalk, commercial driveways, drainage improvements, installing chain link fence, signing, striping and associated work.

The contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid and has executed the contract and provided bonds and insurance documents, which meet the requirements of the contract.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and Mamco, Inc. dba AIAbbasi hereafter called "Contractor".

W I T N E S S E T H

RECITALS:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Temescal Canyon Road and Dos Lagos Drive, Street Improvements Project, El Cerrito Area Adjacent to the City of Corona, Project No. C2-0154**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

AGREEMENT:

IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Contract Documents. The entire contract consists of the following: (a) The Agreement. (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders. (d) The Contractor's Proposal. (e) The Bid Bond. (f) The Payment Bond. (g) The Performance Bond. (h) The General Conditions. (i) The Special Provisions. (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents. (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions. (l) The Plans. (m) Addenda No. **one, two, three, and four**. (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work. (o) Any Change Orders issued. (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Agreement and the Payment Bond and Faithful Performance Bond.
2. The Work. Contractor shall do all things necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion. Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07, "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall begin work within 15 days of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of his intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start. If the project has more than one location of work, a separate notice shall be given for each location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by him in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by him at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- (1) The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
 - (2) All work done according to the contract prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
 - (3) The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".
4. Compensation. Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

 - c. Persons or organizations making claims or bringing "suits".
 3. 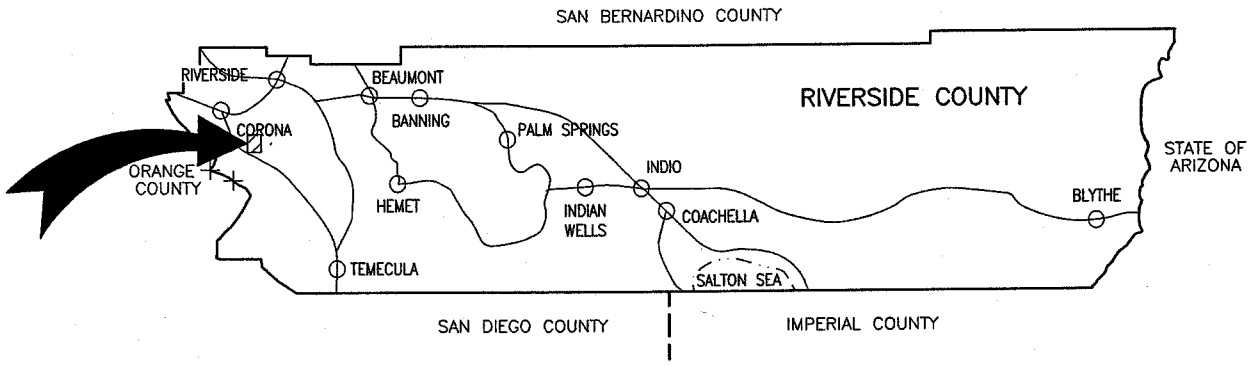

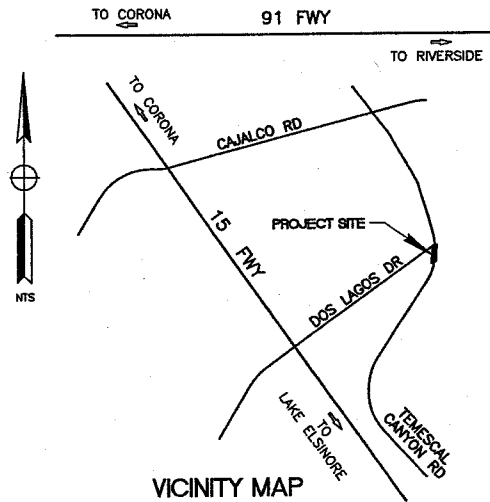

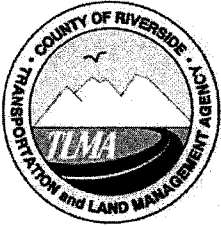

Clearing and Grubbing

Refer to section "Clearing and Grubbing" on page 64 of the Specification Book. The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereof:

Clearing and grubbing shall also include the removal and proper disposal of concrete inlet and any sawcutting tasks and proper removal of existing storm drain pipe to accommodate new manhole.

Full compensation for the removal and proper disposal of concrete inlet with and the sawcutting and removal of existing storm drain pipes to accommodate new manhole shall be paid for on a lump sum basis included in Clearing and Grubbing item for furnishing all labor, equipment, materials and tools, and incidentals at the locations shown on the plans.

Item 3:

Place Asphalt Concrete (Miscellaneous Area)

Refer to section "Place Asphalt Concrete (Miscellaneous Area)" on page 77 of the Special Provisions.

Delete the fourth paragraph of this section.

The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereof:

In areas where a commercial driveway will be constructed adjacent to paved parking lot, the Contractor shall sawcut and remove the existing asphalt concrete, base and subgrade. This area will accommodate the placement of 0.50' thick of asphalt concrete by 15' long, from the back of the commercial driveway approach, by the width of the commercial driveway approach (0.50' Depth X 15' Length X Width of Commercial Driveway) .

On Weirick Road, on locations where commercial driveway and concrete curb and gutter will be constructed, the Contractor shall sawcut and remove a 2' wide section from the existing asphalt, base and subgrade to depth of 2.05'. The Contractor shall place 0.55' asphalt concrete over 1.50' of Class 2 Aggregate Base for these areas.

The Class 2 Aggregate Base shall conform to the Special Provisions for "Aggregate Base".

These provisions shall conform to the special provisions under **Roadway Excavation** with the exception of the Method of Payment of the Roadway Excavation. The sawcutting and removal of the existing asphalt concrete, base and subgrade for Place Asphalt Concrete (Miscellaneous Area) will be paid under the Place Asphalt Concrete (Miscellaneous Area) item of work.

Additionally, the last paragraph (Method of Payment) of the "Place Asphalt Concrete (Miscellaneous Area)" special provisions is deleted and replaced with the following paragraph:

Method of Payment:

The contract unit price paid per square yard for Place Asphalt Concrete (Miscellaneous Area) shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials (other than asphalt concrete), tools, and equipment and for doing all the work involved in placing and compacting asphalt concrete (miscellaneous areas), the sawcutting and removal of existing asphalt concrete, base and subgrade, recompaction of subgrade to 95% relative compaction and the requirements set in these special provisions and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 4: Minor Concrete Sidewalk, Driveway Approach, Curbs, and Gutters
Refer to section "Minor Concrete Sidewalk, Driveway Approach, Curbs and Gutters" on page 78 of the Special Provisions.

Delete the third paragraph and replace it with the following paragraph:

Unless otherwise noted under these special provisions, the area behind and along the concrete improvements shall be filled and compacted with native or selective material and graded to match and provide a smooth transition from the edge of the new improvements to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereof:

Contractor shall remove only the vegetation needed to construct these improvements.

Prior to removal of existing vegetation (trees, shrubs, bushes, and groundcover), the Contractor shall inventory all the existing vegetation (trees, shrubs, bushes, and ground cover) to be removed and replaced. The inventory shall be conducted with the Resident Engineer. Vegetation shall be replaced with the same size and species as the one that was removed and will be paid under various contract items of work involved and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Contractor shall replace any vegetation (trees, shrubs, bushes and groundcover) damaged during the placement of these improvements. Vegetation shall be replaced with the same size and species as the one that was damaged at the Contractor's expense.

Contractor shall relocate, modify, and repair all the existing irrigation lines affected by the construction of this project. Included in the relocation, modification and repair of the existing irrigation is the furnishing of materials and accessories needed to make the existing irrigation system work properly with the replaced vegetation (trees, shrubs, bushes, and ground cover). Existing irrigation system may need to be relocated and modified more than once depending on the staging of this project and will be paid under various contract items of work involved and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor. The modifications in the existing irrigation line shall be performed to the satisfaction of the County Resident Engineer.

If any of the irrigation hand holes are damaged, Contractor shall replace the damage hand holes. Full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved for replacing damaged hand holes shall be paid under various contract items of work involved and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Delete the second paragraph under Method of Payment, and replace it with the following paragraph:

Method of Payment:

The contract unit bid prices paid per square foot for Minor Concrete (Sidewalk) [Including 12" High X 6" Wide Concrete Curb]; per linear foot for Minor Concrete (Curb and Gutter); and per each for Minor Concrete (Commercial Driveway Approach) shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, equipment, materials, tools, and incidentals, the sawcutting and removal of existing asphalt concrete, base and subgrade and for doing all the work involved in the construction and complete in place including the furnishing and placing of expansion joints and these special provisions and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 5: Chain Link Fence

Refer to section "Chain Link Fence" on page 84 of the Specification Book. Delete and replace this section with the following:

CHAIN LINK FENCE AND GATE:

Chain link fence shall be Type CL-4 and CL-6 and shall conform to the provisions of Section 80, and Section 80-4 of the Standard Specifications, plans, and as directed by the Engineer.

The Fence and Gate shall conform to the APWA Standard Plans 600-3.

Method of Payment:

The contract unit bid price paid per linear foot for "Chain Link Fence (CL-4)" and Chain Link Fence (Type CL-6) (Including Gate) shall include full compensation for

furnishing all labor, equipment, materials and tools, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved including the furnishing and installation of the 36' Double Drive Gate, any removal of post and foundation, excavation and backfill with concrete and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 6: Obtain Encroachment Permit

The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereof:

It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to obtain an encroachment permit for any work within the Right-Of-Way of the City of Corona.

There is no construction work shown on the plans within the Jurisdiction of the City of Corona; however, it is anticipated that Contractor may have to obtain an Encroachment permit for Traffic Control and/or striping purpose.

Method of Payment:

Full compensation for all costs associated with "Obtain Encroachment Permit" shall be considered as included in the various items of work involved, and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 7: Miscellaneous Work (As Directed)

The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereof:

Miscellaneous Work (As Directed) shall consist of necessary work that is not included in other contract bid items, as determined by the Engineer. Miscellaneous work shall be performed as directed by the Engineer and in accordance with the applicable standards and specifications.

Method of Payment:

Payment for implementing miscellaneous work (as directed) will be paid for on a force account basis, in accordance with Section 9-1.03 of the Standard Specifications, up to the fixed bid price, for the work performed.
