BACKGROUND: (Continued)

The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to construct a grade separation at the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) and Clay Street at-grade crossing in the City of Jurupa Valley. Clay Street is designated as a major arterial highway and serves as a connection between Limonite Avenue and Van Buren Boulevard. The existing grade on Clay Street would be lowered to obtain vertical clearance between Clay Street and the existing railroad tracks (Project).

Connection of the proposed grade separation would require a temporary shoe-fly track adjacent to and north of the existing UPRR mainline. A shoe-fly is a temporary by-pass necessary to maintain rail circulation through the project area during construction of the new structure. Upon completion of the structure, the shoe-fly would be removed, and property reverted back to the property owner.

The Project is needed in order to improve traffic flow and increase public safety by eliminating the conflicting train/vehicle movement. This will serve to end traffic delays for motorists and emergency vehicles traveling north or south on Clay Street caused by the at-grade crossing, as well as improve the efficient movement of goods through Riverside County.

The Notice of Exemption was filed and posted on February 9, 2011. RCTD staff conducted a review of the Project and it is exempt for the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) based on Section 15282(h).

The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) environmental determination (Categorical Exclusion Section 6004; 23 CFR 771.117(d)(3) was approved on January 31, 2011, by District 8 Division of Environmental Planning for the California Department of Transportation.

The Economic Development Agency/Facilities Management (EDA/FM) has presented a written offer to the property owners as required by Government Code Section 7267.2. The amount of the offer is consistent with current property values in the Jurupa Valley area for the various property types (and is based upon a fair market value appraisal report). Dear Members of the Board:

This firm represents MMI & BDI Riverside General, LLC ("MMI") regarding the County of Riverside's ("County") proposed acquisition of a portion of MMI's property identified by the County as Parcel Nos. 0753-001A, 0001B and 001C and Parcel Nos. 0753-011A, 011B, 011C, 011D and 011E (collectively the "Subject Property"). We have received notice of the County's intent to adopt a resolution of necessity authorizing the taking of the Subject Property by condemnation for the Clay Street Grade Separation Project (the "Project"). Based upon this notice, we understand that the County's hearing is scheduled for April 23, 2013 at 9:30 a.m.

The purpose of this letter is to provide a formal written objection in lieu of personally appearing at the hearing on behalf of MMI to the adoption of the proposed resolution of necessity. Accordingly, while we do not plan to appear at the hearing, we request that this letter be considered by the Board and included as part of the formal record of administrative proceedings for this item.

MMI objects to the adoption of the proposed resolution of necessity on each of the following specific grounds:

 The County's Proposed Project Is Not Planned Or Located In The Manner That Will Be Most Compatible With The Greatest Public Good And The Least Private Injury.

One of the necessary findings that must be made before the adoption of a resolution to authorize the taking of private property is whether the proposed project for which the property is sought to be taken is planned or located in a manner that is most compatible with the greatest public good and causes the least private injury. (Code Civ. Proc., § 1240.030, subd. (b).) "This limitation, which involves essentially a comparison between two or more sites, has also been described as 'the necessity for adopting a particular plan' for a given public improvement.".

Legislative Committee Comment to Section 1240.030. In the absence of substantial evidence supporting the County's determination as to the planning and location of the proposed project, the Resolution of Necessity is invalid.

Here, the proposed Project is not compatible with the greatest public good while causing the least private injury. Notably, the actual grade separation contemplated by the County does not abut either of the properties owned by MMI of which the Subject Property is part. Instead, both of the properties owned by MMI are far enough away from the actual grade separation that with the effort of redesigning the Project, there would be no need to take the Subject Property. This is particularly true with APN 163-400-016 (County Parcel No. 0753-011E), which is far removed from the area of the grade separation. Because the Project can be redesigned with minimal effort in a manner that will require either no taking of the Subject Property or dramatically less of the Subject Property, the Project is not compatible with the greatest public good while causing the least private injury.

2. The County Failed To Extend A Legitimate Pre-condemnation Offer Pursuant to Government Code Section 7267.2.

Government Code Section 7267.6 requires that the County make a legitimate offer of compensation based upon an approved appraisal prior to initiating condemnation proceedings. A written statement and a summary basis for the offer must include sufficient details to indicate clearly the basis for the offer. (Gov. Code, § 7267.2, subd. (b).) These provisions are not merely discretionary guidelines, but mandatory requirements which must be observed by any public entity planning to initiate eminent domain proceedings through a resolution of necessity. City of San Jose v. Great Oaks Water Company (1987) 192 Cal.App.3d 1005, 1013.

One of the primary requirements of Section 7267.2 is that the public entity must establish the just compensation for the property to be taken. When the use of the diminution-invalue test fails to reflect accurately the extent of loss, severance damages may be measured by the cost of restoring the injured remainder to the same relative position in which it stood before the public project was begun. People ex rel Dep't of Pub. Works v. Hayward Bldg. Materials Co. (1963) 213 Cal.App.2d 457 (cost to cure measured by, e.g., costs of paving reconstruction, dismantling of old shop, relocation of electric lines, spur track); City of Riverside v. Kraft (1962) 203 Cal.App.2d 300 (cost to cure measured by costs of relocating shrubs, trees and flowers necessitated by moving of houses on land not taken). "The Owner is to be put in as good a position pecuniarily as he would have occupied if his property had not been taken from him." People ex rel Dep't Pub. Works v. Lynbar, Inc. (1967) 253 Cal.App.2d 870, 880.

The County's past offers of just compensation are insufficient as they failed to fully account for MMI's recoverable severance damages including, but not limited to, its costs to cure in the form of the cost to move the water line on APN 163-400-016 (County Parcel No. 0753-11E). The County is well aware of the need to move the water line, but neglected to include in its offer any compensation for the removal costs.

The County's October 30, 2012 offer of compensation ("Offer Letter") failed to satisfy the requirement under Section 7267.2 that the County provide to the owner "a written statement of,

and summary of the basis for, the amount it established as just compensation." Although the Offer Letter and "Appraisal Summary Statement" attached thereto purport to summarize the basis of the amount offered as just compensation, in reality they fail to do so. For example, the Offer Letter references land sales summaries of between \$5.28 and \$11.10 per square foot, yet the appraiser selected — without any explanation — a land value of \$6 per square foot.

3. The County's Proposed Project Is Not Planned Or Located In The Manner That Will Be Most Compatible With The Greatest Public Good And The Least Private Injury.

In the absence of substantial evidence supporting the County's determination as to the planning and location of the proposed project, the Resolution of Necessity is invalid.

Here, the proposed Project is not compatible with the greatest public good while causing the least private injury. Notably, the actual grade separation contemplated by the County does not abut either of the properties owned by MMI of which the Subject Property is part. Instead, both of the properties owned by MMI are far enough away from the actual grade separation that with the effort of redesigning the Project, there would be no need to take the Subject Property. This is particularly true with APN 163-400-016 (County Parcel No. 0753-011E), which is far removed from the area of the grade separation. Because the Project can be redesigned with minimal effort in a manner that will require either no taking of the Subject Property or dramatically less of the Subject Property, the Project is not compatible with the greatest public good while causing the least private injury.

4. The Hearing On The Proposed Resolution Of Necessity is Inappropriate Because The Agency Is Already Irrevocably Committed To Adopting The Resolution Of Necessity.

MMI is concerned that no meaningful consideration of its objections and concerns will take place at the hearing of the resolution of necessity concerning the proposed Project given that the County appears to have already committed itself to acquiring the Subject Property.

Redevelopment Agency v. Norm's Slauson (1991) 173 Cal.App.3d 1121, addressed such a situation. In that case, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Huntington Park brought an action in eminent domain to take a major portion of a restaurant's parking lot. The redevelopment agency's attempt to take the property in question was preceded by an agreement between the agency and a developer by which the agency agreed to acquire the property for transfer to the developer and the developer would build a condominium project thereon. The Court of Appeal started its analysis with an explanation of the purpose of a hearing on a resolution of necessity: "Implicit in this requirement of a hearing and the adoption of a resolution of necessity is the concept that, in arriving at its decision to take, the Agency

engage in a good faith and judicious consideration of the pros and cons of the issue and that the decision be buttressed by substantial evidence of the existence of the three basic requirements set forth in Code of Civil Procedure, section 1240.030." Id. at pp. 1124-25. In affirming the trial court's determination that the agency had not right to take the property, the court concluded that: "[i]t seems clear that the hearing which led to the adoption of the resolution of necessity was a sham and the Agency's policy-making board simply 'rubber stamped' a predetermined result." Id. at p. 1127. The Court also stated that: "By the time the agency actually conducted a hearing to determine the 'necessity' for taking the property in question, it had, by virtue of its contract with the developer and issuance of revenue bonds, irrevocably committed itself to take the property in question, regardless of any evidence that might be presented at the hearing." Id.

The concerns raised by the court in <u>Norm's Slauson</u> apply with equal vigor here as the County has irrevocably committed to acquire the Subject Property. Presumably, numerous contracts have been executed with various third party vendors and contractors and Metro will simply be "rubber stamping" a predetermined result. Accordingly, MMI is concerned that despite what objections or evidence may be presented at the April 23, 2013 hearing on the resolution of necessity for the proposed Project, the hearing will be nothing more than a procedural technicality due to the fact that the County has irrevocably committed itself to take the Subject Property.

5. The Proposed Project Does Not Comply With The California Environmental Quality Act.

The County cannot lawfully proceed with the proposed Project as it has not complied with CEQA. The County's determination that environmental review is not required for the Project is incorrect. Here, the Project is just one of several successive proposed grade separation projects. Therefore, the Project, along with the other proposed grade separation projects, will result in cumulative impacts which have not been identified and studied by the County. The Project therefore presents unusual circumstances which create the reasonable possibility of significant impacts, meaning that proper environmental review of the Project should take place.

We ask that the County consider the objections raised herein, and accordingly decline to adopt the proposed resolution of necessity on April 23. Please contact me with any questions.

- (d) That the offers required by Section 7267.2 of the Government Code have been made to the owner of record of the Subject Properties;
- (e) That, to the extent that the Subject Properties are already devoted to a public use, the use of the Proposed Project is a compatible use that will not unreasonably interfere with or impair the continuance of the public use as it presently exists or may reasonably be expected to exist in the future (California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1240.510) or the use of the Proposed Project is a more necessary public use than is the presently existing public use (California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1240.610);
- (f) That the Subject Property Interests are necessary for the Proposed Project;
- (g) That acquisition of the Subject Property Interests will promote the interests of the County of Riverside.

- 2. If (within 15 days from the mailing of this Notice) you file a written request to appear at the public meeting and be heard on the matters described above in 1(a), 1(b), 1(c), 1(d), 1(e), 1(f), 1(g), (or any one or more of them), you will have a right to appear at that meeting and be heard on those matters.
- 3. All such written requests to appear and be heard must be filed with the Clerk of the Riverside County Board of Supervisors.
- 4. Your written request to appear and be heard must be filed within the fifteen (15) day time period. Failure to file such a timely written request will result in a waiver of your right to appear and be heard.
- 5. Questions regarding the amount of compensation to be paid will not be a part of the public meeting and the Board will not consider such questions in determining whether a Resolution of Necessity should be adopted.
- 6. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall cause a copy of this Notice to be sent by first-class mail to each person whose property may be acquired by eminent domain and whose name and address appears on the last equalized county assessment roll (including the roll of state-assessed property).
