BACKGROUND:

The contract documents have been approved as to form by County Counsel. A brief project description and location map are attached.

The General Manager-Chief Engineer has determined that the proposed project meets the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) statutory exemption cited in Public Resources Code §21080.21 stating that CEQA does not apply to any project of less than one mile in length within a public street or highway or any other public right-of-way for the installation of new pipeline or the maintenance, repair, restoration, reconditioning, relocation, replacement, removal, or demolition of an existing pipeline. For purposes of this exemption, "pipeline" includes subsurface facilities but does not include any surface facility related to the operation of the underground facility. A CEQA Notice of Exemption has been prepared and will be filed with the Clerk-Recorder's Office in accordance with CEQA.

The proposed project is not within the Criteria Area or Public/Quasi-Public (P/QP) lands set forth in and established by the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). The proposed project site does not meet the MSHCP definition of riparian/riverine areas or vernal pools. In addition, the proposed project lacks suitable habitat for the species listed in Section 6.1.2 of the MSHCP. Therefore, no analysis or survey is required. The proposed project is not located within a mapped survey area for the Narrow Endemic Plant Species. Therefore, no habitat assessment or survey is required under Section 6.1.3 of the MSHCP. The proposed project is not located within a mapped survey area for plant, amphibian, mammal species or Burrowing Owls. Therefore, no habitat assessment or survey is required under Section 6.3.2 of the MSHCP.

Project Title: Sunnymead MDP Line P-6, Stage 2 (Project No. 4-0-00716-02)

Project Location - Specific:

The proposed project is located in the city of Moreno Valley within the existing Eucalyptus Avenue road right of way generally between Perris Boulevard to the west and Tamara Drive to the east. The project will begin approximately 600 linear feet east of Perris Boulevard and continue easterly 750 linear feet. The proposed project is located within Township 3 South, Range 3 West, SBBM, Sections 5 & 8 of the Sunnymead 7.5 Minute US Geological Survey (USGS) Topographic Quadrangle.

Project Description:

The proposed project consists of the construction and subsequent maintenance of approximately 750 linear feet of underground storm drain (33-36 inch reinforced concrete pipe) and catch basins. The purpose of the project is to provide flood protection to the adjacent businesses and residences.


Director of Industrial Relations of the State of California for the area where the work is to be done. The said determinations are on file in the principal office of the District, and will be made available to any interested person upon request.

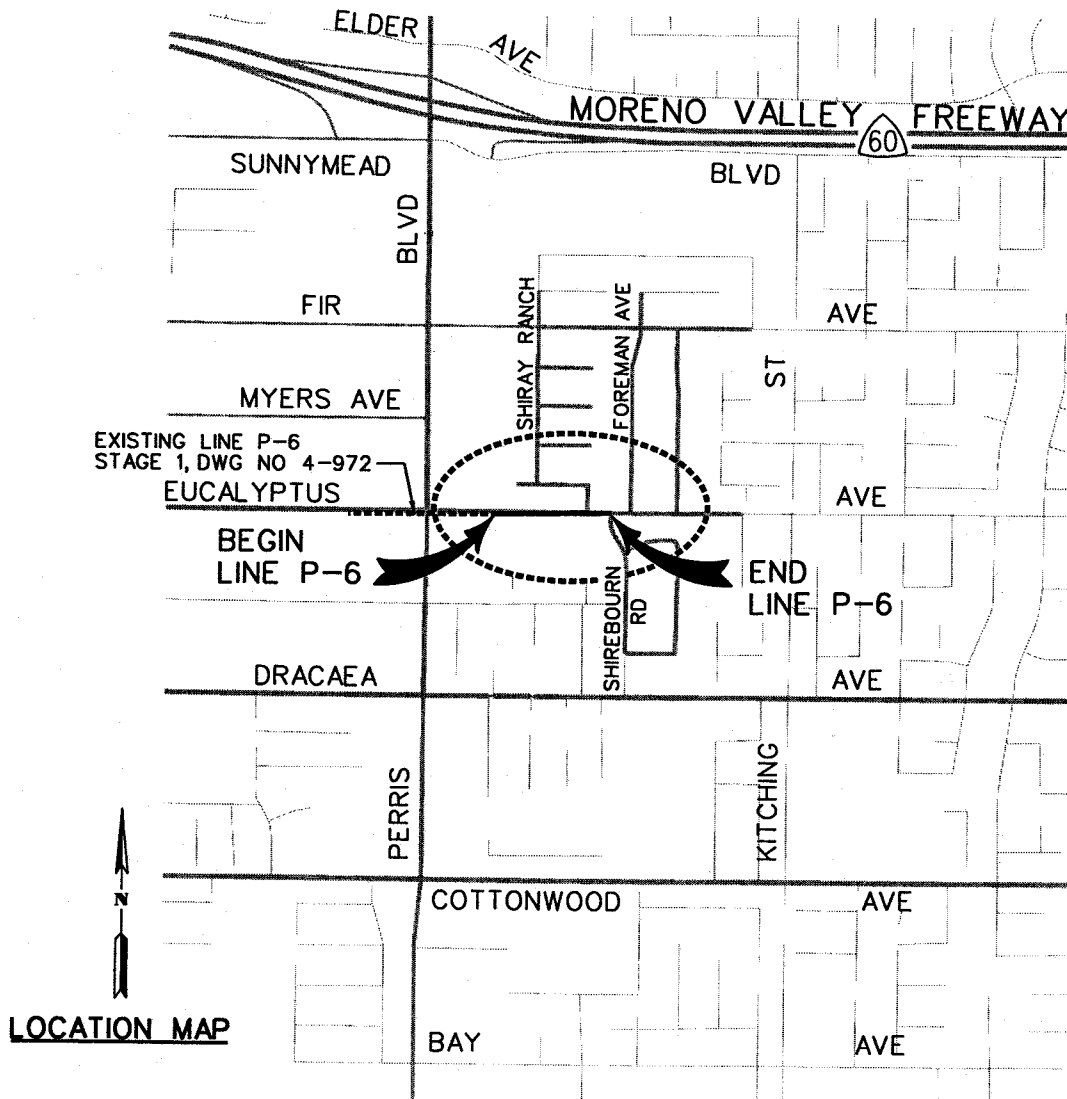

Sunnymead MDP Line P-6, Stage 2 - This project is an underground storm drain approximately 700 lineal feet of reinforced concrete pipe ranging in size from 36" to 24". The project starts approximately 600 lineal feet east of the intersection of Perris Boulevard and Eucalyptus Avenue and ends at the intersection of Eucalyptus Avenue and Shirebourn Road in the city of Moreno Valley. It will tie into the existing storm drain facility of Sunnymead MDP Line P-6, Stage 1.
