3. Award the contract to All American Asphalt and authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to execute the contract documents; and
4. Approve the project's proposed budget as given on Attachment A.

**BACKGROUND:** By Minute Order dated January 29, 2013 (Agenda Item 3.45), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Indiana Avenue and Grant Street roadway improvements in the community of Home Gardens.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the specifications and special provisions. Bidders are required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their Contractor's Proposal. The addendum was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 20, 2013. Eleven bids were received, ranging from \$212,027 to \$292,300. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt of Corona, CA in the amount of \$212,027, which is \$12,573 (5.6%) below the Engineer's Estimate. The project is expected to finish within the existing budget as shown on Attachment A.

The project will include roadway reconstruction, roadway resurfacing, sidewalk, and driveway and access ramp reconstruction. The reconstruction includes approximately 500 linear feet of Indiana Avenue and Grant Street. The resurfacing includes approximately 700 linear feet of Grant Street. Additional improvements include the removal and reconstruction of concrete curb and gutter, driveway approaches, curb ramps and sidewalk, construction of a new concrete cross gutter and spandrel, placement of asphalt concrete dike and driveways, striping, pavement markings, and associated work improvements. The reconstruction will allow for improved drainage and pedestrian access.

The award documents include the following schedules of work:

Base Bid: Primary items of work.

Alternate 1: Home Gardens Sanitary District (HGSD) – Provide, replace, and adjust manhole frame and cover to grade. **Not selected for award.**

Alternate 2: HGSD – Adjust existing manhole frame and cover to grade.

The work included in Alternate 2 is recommended for award. The costs for the work will be reimbursed by HGSD under a previously executed funding agreement.

The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds are being provided through a grant administered by the County of Riverside Economic Development Agency.

The Contractor will execute the contract and provide bonds and insurance documents after Board of Supervisors' approval. The Contractor is qualified to perform the proposed work.

**AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **All American Asphalt** hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

RECITALS:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Indiana Avenue, Home Gardens Road Improvement (Phase II), Project No. C2-0138, Community Development Block Grant, CDBG No. 2.27-09**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

AGREEMENT:

IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Contract Documents. The entire contract consists of the following: (a) The Agreement. (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders. (d) The Contractor's Proposal. (e) The Bid Bond. (f) The Payment Bond. (g) The Performance Bond. (h) The General Conditions. (i) The Special Provisions. (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents. (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions. (l) The Plans. (m) Addenda No. **One**. (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work. (o) Any Change Orders issued. (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. **(q) The Special Federal Requirements found in the 'Federal Funding Requirements' section of the Special Provisions.** All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Agreement and the Payment Bond and Faithful Performance Bond.

2. The Work. Contractor shall do all things necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.
3. Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion. Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07, "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall begin work within 15 days of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of his intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start. If the project has more than one location of work, a separate notice shall be given for each location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by him in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by him at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- (1) The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- (2) All work done according to the contract prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- (3) The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation. Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.
