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BACKGROUND (cont):

The storm drain improvements are to be jointly inspected by the District and City. Upon completion of the construction, the District will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the mainline storm drain and the City will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the associated laterals and appurtenances such as catch basins, connector pipes, etc.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to legal form and the City has executed the Agreement.

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

West End Moreno MDP Line LL, Stage 1 (Project No. 4-0-00783-01)

The RIVERSIDE COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, hereinafter called "DISTRICT", and the CITY OF MORENO VALLEY, hereinafter called "CITY", hereby agree as follows:

RECITALS

- A. DISTRICT has budgeted for and plans to construct West End Moreno Master Drainage Plan (MDP) Line LL, Stage 1, in order to provide necessary flood protection and improved drainage within the community of Edgemont, located within the City of Moreno Valley; and
- B. West End Moreno Master Drainage Plan (MDP) Line LL, Stage 1, as shown on DISTRICT Drawing No. 4-826, consists of approximately 2,900 lineal feet of underground drainage system as shown in concept in blue on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, and hereinafter called "DISTRICT DRAINAGE FACILITIES"; and
- C. Associated with the construction of DISTRICT DRAINAGE FACILITIES is the construction of certain catch basins, connector pipes, and storm drains that are thirty-six inches (36") or less in diameter located within CITY held easements or rights of way, hereinafter called "APPURTENANCES". Together, DISTRICT DRAINAGE FACILITIES and APPURTENANCES are hereinafter called "PROJECT"; and
- D. DISTRICT is willing to (i) prepare plans and specifications for PROJECT in accordance with applicable DISTRICT and CITY standards, (ii) advertise, award and administer a public works construction contract for PROJECT, (iii) inspect the construction of PROJECT, and (iv) fund all costs for the design, construction and inspection of PROJECT as set forth herein; and

E.	CITY is willing to (i) review and approve plans and specifications for PROJECT
(ii) grant DI	STRICT the right to construct PROJECT within CITY rights of way, (iii) inspec
construction	of PROJECT, and (iv) upon completion of PROJECT construction of, assume
ownership, o	peration and maintenance responsibility of APPURTENANCES; and

- F. It is in the best interest of the public to proceed with the construction of PROJECT at the earliest possible date; and
- G. The purpose of this Agreement is to memorialize the understandings by and amongst CITY and DISTRICT with respect to the funding, construction, inspection, ownership, operation and maintenance of PROJECT.
 - H. NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

SECTION I

DISTRICT shall:

- 1. Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), act as the Lead Agency and assume responsibility for the preparation, circulation, and adoption of all necessary and appropriate CEQA documents pertaining to the construction, operation and maintenance of PROJECT.
- 2. Prepare, at its sole cost and expense, construction plans and specification documents for PROJECT in accordance with applicable DISTRICT and CITY standards and submit to CITY for review and approval prior to advertising a public works construction contract for PROJECT.
- 3. Obtain all necessary rights of way, rights of entry and temporary construction easements necessary to construct, inspect, operate and maintain PROJECT.

4. Secure, at its sole cost and expense, all necessary permits, approvals, licenses or agreements required by any Federal or State resource or regulatory agencies pertaining to the construction, operation and maintenance of PROJECT.

- 5. Advertise, award and administer a public works contract for the construction of PROJECT.
- 6. Provide CITY with written notice that DISTRICT has awarded a construction contract for PROJECT.
- 7. Notify CITY in writing at least twenty (20) days prior to the start of construction of PROJECT.
- 8. Construct or cause to be constructed, PROJECT pursuant to a DISTRICT administered public works contract in accordance with DISTRICT and CITY approved plans and specifications and pay all costs associated therewith.
 - 9. Inspect the construction of PROJECT.
- 10. At its own expense, relocate all sanitary sewers and all other utilities which conflict with the construction of PROJECT, except for any utilities that CITY orders to be relocated at the utility company's expense.
- 11. Not permit any change to or modification of CITY approved PROJECT plans and specifications that would result in change of function or maintainability of APPURTENANCES without the prior written permission and consent of CITY.
- 12. Within two (2) weeks of completing PROJECT construction, provide CITY with written notice that PROJECT construction is substantially complete and request CITY to conduct a final inspection of PROJECT.
- 13. Provide CITY with a copy of the Notice of Completion upon completion of PROJECT construction and settlement of any outstanding claims.

14. Provide CITY with a duplicate copy of 'Record Drawing' plans for PROJECT following DISTRICT'S acceptance of PROJECT construction as being complete.

SECTION II

CITY shall:

- 1. Act as a Responsible Agency under CEQA, and take all necessary and appropriate action to comply with CEQA.
- 2. Review and approve PROJECT plans and specifications, at its sole cost and expense, prior to DISTRICT advertising PROJECT for construction bids.
- 3. Grant DISTRICT, by execution of this Agreement, all rights to construct, inspect operate and maintain PROJECT within CITY rights of way.
- 4. Issue a no fee encroachment permit to DISTRICT'S contractor(s) to construct PROJECT within CITY rights of way.
- 5. Order the relocation of all utilities installed by permit or franchise within CITY rights of way that are in conflict with the construction of PROJECT and which must be relocated at the utilities company's expense.
- 6. Inspect construction of PROJECT, at its sole cost and expense, as set forth in Section III.1.
- 7. Upon receipt of DISTRICT'S written notice that PROJECT construction is substantially complete as set forth in Section I.12, conduct a final inspection of PROJECT.
- 8. Accept ownership and sole responsibility for the operation and maintenance of APPURTENANCES upon (i) receipt of DISTRICT'S Notice of Completion as set forth in Section I.13 and (ii) receipt of a duplicate copy of 'Record Drawing' plans for PROJECT as set forth in Section I.14.

9. Upon DISTRICT acceptance of PROJECT construction as being complete, accept sole responsibility for the adjustment of all PROJECT manhole rings and covers located within CITY rights of way which must be performed at such time(s) that the finished grade along and above the underground portions of DISTRICT DRAINAGE FACILITIES are improved, repaired, replaced or changed. It being further understood and agreed that any such adjustments shall be performed at no cost to DISTRICT.

SECTION III

It is further mutually agreed:

- 1. CITY personnel may observe and inspect all work being done on PROJECT but shall provide any comments to DISTRICT personnel who shall be responsible for all communications with DISTRICT'S construction contractor(s).
- 2. Except as otherwise provided herein, all construction work involved with PROJECT shall be inspected by DISTRICT but shall not be deemed complete until DISTRICT and CITY mutually agree that construction is completed.
- 3. CITY shall indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless DISTRICT and the County of Riverside (including their respective officers, districts, special districts and departments, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents, representatives, independent contractors, and subcontractors) from any liabilities, claim, damage, proceeding or action, present or future, based upon, arising out of or in any way relating to CITY (including its officers, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents, representatives, independent contractors, and subcontractors) actual or alleged acts or omissions related to this Agreement, performance under this Agreement, or failure to comply with the requirements of this Agreement, including but not limited to: (a) property damage; (b)

bodily injury or death; (c) payment of attorney's fees; or (d) any other element of any kind or nature whatsoever.

- 4. DISTRICT shall indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless CITY (including its officers, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents, representatives, independent contractors, and subcontractors) from any liabilities, claim, damage, proceeding or action, present or future, based upon, arising out of or in any way relating to DISTRICT (including its officers, Board of Supervisors, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents, representatives, independent contractors, and subcontractors) actual or alleged acts or omissions related to this Agreement, performance under this Agreement, or failure to comply with the requirements of this Agreement, including but not limited to: (a) property damage; (b) bodily injury or death; (c) payment of attorney's fees; or (d) any other element of any kind or nature whatsoever.
- 5. Any waiver by DISTRICT or CITY of any breach by the other of any one or more of the terms of this Agreement shall not be construed to be a waiver of any subsequent or other breach of the same or of any other term hereof. Failure on the part of DISTRICT or CITY to require from the others exact, full and complete compliance with any terms of this Agreement shall not be construed as in any manner changing the terms hereof, or estopping DISTRICT or CITY from enforcement hereof.
- 6. Any and all notices sent or required to be sent to the parties of this Agreement will be mailed by first class mail, postage prepaid, to the following addresses:

- 7. If any provision in this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect without being impaired or invalidated in any way.
- 8. This Agreement is to be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California.
- 9. This Agreement is made and entered into for the sole protection and benefit of the parties hereto. No other person or entity shall have any right of action based upon the provisions of this Agreement.
- 10. This Agreement is the result of negotiations between the parties hereto, and with the advice and assistance of their respective counsel. No provision contained herein shall be construed against DISTRICT solely because, as a matter of convenience, it prepared this Agreement in its final form.
- 11. This Agreement is intended by the parties hereto as a final expression of their understanding with respect to the subject matter hereof, and is a complete and exclusive statement of the terms and conditions thereof. This Agreement may be changed or modified only upon the written consent of the parties hereto.
- 12. DISTRICT and CITY each pledge to cooperate in regard to the operation and maintenance of their respective facilities as set forth herein and to discharge their respective maintenance responsibilities in an expeditious fashion so as to avoid the creation of any nuisance condition or undue maintenance impact upon the other's facilities.


