BACKGROUND:

On June 28, 2011, the Board of Supervisors approved the award of the construction agreement to AWI Builders, Inc. Pursuant to the General Conditions of the contract, the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency is currently retaining 10% of all progress payments to AWI Builders, Inc. The General Conditions of the contract state that after the 50% completion of the contract work, if satisfactory progress is being made, the County has sole discretion to reduce the retention to a minimum of 5% of the contract. AWI Builders, Inc. has completed 70% of the contract work and satisfactory progress has been made. Therefore, the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency recommends that the contract retention be reduced to 5%. This Board action will release \$839,720 in retained funds to the contractor.

Sufficient funds for this project are budgeted for FY 2012/13. All costs associated with this project will be funded by I-215 Corridor Redevelopment Project Area Bond Funds, which is indicated in the previously approved budget, thus no net County costs will be incurred.
