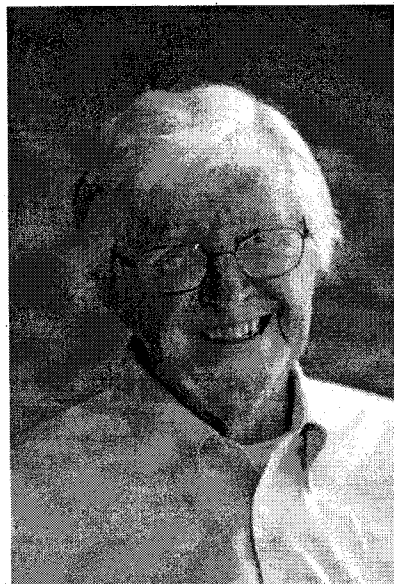

Riverside volunteer Harry Joseph Hood, 87, who had been active in more than a dozen civic and religious organizations, many promoting social justice, died early Monday morning, May 27, at Sunrise at Canyon Crest in Riverside.

"He enjoyed being involved in causes he believed in," said his wife, June O'Connor, who was head of the religious studies department at UC Riverside.

Mr. Hood was past president of the United Nations Association chapter and said in 2008 the group's goals and principles, talking about differences and finding common ground, united his other involvement.



He was also active with The Group, a Riverside public policy advocacy organization focused mostly on issues concerning the black community; the Latino Network; Office on Aging; League of Women Voters; Seasons of Grace, Social Justice Committee at St. Andrew's Newman Center; Book Club Sunday, Police Advisory Committee; Riverside Coalition for Police Accountability; Uptown Kiwanis Club; AARP; and the Current Events and Friday Morning Discussion groups at Janet Goeske Senior Center.

Mr. Hood always looked for the good in other people, said Ofelia Valdez-Yeager, who worked with him in the Latino Network and other causes.

"Harry was a person who just lit up the room when he came in," Valdez-Yeager said. "He brought so many individuals together."

She said he inspired many people, including her daughters, to volunteer to build a house for Habitat for Humanity.

Mr. Hood retired in 1992 as an administrator at the University of La Verne, where he spent almost 20 years as a teacher and administrator.

He and O'Connor had moved to Riverside in 1972, a month after they married and when she was offered a position at UCR.






He had previously been a Catholic priest in the Marianist Order, working as an educator in Switzerland and Puerto Rico.

After leaving the priesthood, he met O'Connor in Philadelphia.

They have one daughter, Meagan, a school psychologist in San Diego.

Services will be at 1 p.m. Saturday, June 15, at St. Andrew's Newman Center, 105 W. Big Spring Road, Riverside.

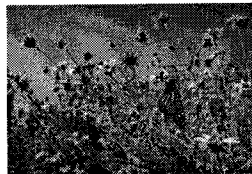

Former Corona-Norco school board member Sharon Martinez, 58, who never allowed the pain of cancer to compromise her passion for education, died Saturday, June 1, at her Corona home. She was 58.

Mrs. Martinez's family was with her as she died.

Her husband, Richard, recalled how she had battled breast cancer five times since she was 35 years old, "and she defeated every one." But six years ago, she was diagnosed with scleroderma, a systemic autoimmune disease, which turned out to be a disease she couldn't beat.

She told me two weeks ago how tired and in pain she was, and that it was time to go. Her husband said.

First elected to the Corona-Norco Unified School District in 1997, Mrs. Martinez served for 13 years. She was serving her third term when, in 2010, she retired for health reasons.

Bill Hedrick was a friend and a colleague, serving with Mrs. Martinez on the school board during those 13 years. While students always came first, he said, "She had a special affinity for school custodians, food services workers and secretaries. She was their foremost advocate, and there wasn't one whom she didn't know."

Cathy Sciorinto, another close friend who served with her on the board, recalled having lunch with Mrs. Martinez one day about four years ago. Driving along Lincoln Avenue after leaving Goodfellas restaurant, the two noticed a stray dog on the sidewalk of the busy street.

"That little dog is going to get hit," Mrs. Martinez said. They stopped and picked up the terrier mix.

"I'll find her a home," Mrs. Martinez said. But she didn't. That little dog was her constant companion during her last years.

"That's the kind of person Sharon was," Sciorino said. "She was so genuine and loving."

Outside of education, Mrs. Martinez volunteered her time and talents to a number of organizations including Peppermint Ridge, the 100 Mile Club, the Fender Museum, Walk for Life and Unity.

Mrs. Martinez, born in Dewitt, N.Y., and her husband, Richard, met while both were working for Pacific Bell. They were married for 31 years, and raised two sons they had together, Andrew, 30, and Chad, 27; and a third, Todd, 35, Richard's son from a previous marriage.

She is also survived by her mother, Evelyn Malikow, who has been with her for the past two weeks.

Richard Martinez called his wife "my best friend. We professed our love every morning, noon and night, and there was nothing we couldn't say to each other."

There were good days and bad days during those six years, he said, "but no one would ever know that she was having a bad day. Ask her how she felt, and she would say, 'Splendid!'"

The news, while not unexpected, prompted an emotional reaction from many whose lives Mrs. Martinez touched as a school board member and volunteer.

Corona Mayor Jason Scott, himself an educator, called her "a champion for children, a friend to all who met her, a tower of strength and determination, an inspiration and a love."

Norco City Councilman Kevin Bash said he met Mrs. Martinez, whom he called a "wonderful, loving person," through the American Youth Soccer Organization.

"She was a tireless volunteer along with her husband (Richard), both of whom devoted thousands of volunteer hours to our communities' children," Bash said.

Corona Councilman Dick Haley also met Mrs. Martinez through AYSO, where he was a referee.

"Like everything else she did, she was very dedicated to the support of the players first, then everyone else," Haley said. "She never hesitated to 'assist' us referees from the sidelines and even after the games with her own critiques of how well we did or not.

"She always had a positive attitude. She actually told me, with a big grin, that her disabled (license) plate let her have the best parking places. She looked for the best in everything."
