BACKGROUND: In 1992, the County executed a cooperative agreement with the City of Palm Desert and Palm Desert Redevelopment Agency providing for payment quarterly to the County an amount equal to the sales and use taxes paid to the City generated by the shopping center at the intersection of Monterey Avenue and Dinah Shore Drive for the purpose of addressing unmet health, mental health, and juvenile services in eastern Riverside County. In 1993, the County contracted with the Regional Access Project, Inc. (RAP), a non-profit foundation, to use those proceeds for such services. The original budgeted revenue estimate for FY 12/13 was \$1,350,000. However, the amount of revenue owed the County under this agreement based on actual sales and use tax receipts generated by the site is estimated to be \$1,435,589. The recommended adjustments provide appropriations necessary to allocate fully to RAP the estimated FY 12/13 third and fourth quarter revenue.
