BACKGROUND continued: As Board members suggested at the March 26, 2013 meeting, the committee could be reconstituted in January 2015 or at another date the Board deems appropriate, to revisit the county's strategic vision.

Discussion at the meeting also focused on the duration of boards, committees and commissions. Policy A-21 addresses that issue, stating, "In instances where it is not justified that an advisory group exist indefinitely, the Board shall include a sunset clause in the document establishing the advisory group specifying a definite sunset date." By policy, the Board also may establish a sunset date for any commission that does not currently have such a date.

The Board may establish a sunset date for advisory groups at any convenient opportunity or during comprehensive reviews of all the groups. Once such a sunset date occurs, advisory groups are considered dissolved and shall cease to meet unless or until the Board of Supervisors approves a time extension and a new sunset date.

A comprehensive review into the status of all county boards, commissions and committees will be conducted every two years, to ensure that panels do not remain constituted if they have become inactive or unneeded. The periodic review is described in Board Policy A-21 and also provides a means to address any changes in county advisory boards' operations. The recommendations in the attached report and resolutions address advisory groups that should be dissolved. Background data and recommendations from the departments most directly associated with each advisory group were used in formulating the Executive Office recommended actions.

The organizer of the presentation will automatically receive the first three (3) minutes, with the remaining six (6) minutes relinquished by other speakers, as requested by them on a completed "Request to Speak" form, and clearly indicated at the front bottom of the form.

Addressing the Board & Acknowledgement by Chairman:

The Chairman will determine what order the speakers will address the Board, and will call on all speakers in pairs. The first speaker should immediately step to the podium and begin addressing the Board. The second speaker should take up a position in one of the chamber aisles in order to quickly step up to the podium after the preceding speaker. This is to afford an efficient and timely Board meeting, giving all attendees the opportunity to make their case. Speakers are prohibited from making personal attacks, and/or using coarse, crude, profane or vulgar language while speaking to the Board members, staff, the general public and/or meeting participants. Such behavior, at the discretion of the Board Chairman may result in removal from the Board Chambers by Sheriff Deputies.
