RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors introduce and adopt, on successive meetings, Ordinance No. 452.234, amending Ordinance No. 452 relating to prima facie speed limits to establish various speed zones in the above-referenced areas of Riverside County.

BACKGROUND: Transportation Department staff has conducted Engineering and Traffic Surveys (E&TS) for various roads in Mecca, Murrieta, Perris, and Temecula areas of Riverside County, as required by the California Vehicle Code.

Based upon the results of the E&TS for these roads, the radar-enforceable speed limits
