BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- Casa Blanca Home of Neighborly Service-\$2,000 to support the Computer Learning
 Center and Literacy Program, a one year after school program geared to improving
 students' literacy skills. 50 students from Casa Blanca in grades 1-12 will benefit from this
 program.
- 2. The Unforgettables Foundation-\$1,000 to support their Burial Project which provides funding to families who cannot afford a proper burial for their child.
- 3. City of Riverside-Parks, Recreation and Community Service Department -\$500 to support the 2013 Mariachi Festival in the City of Riverside. This is a 2-day festival which includes live performances by various mariachi bands, food and novelty vendors, a ballet folkloric dance competition and showcase demonstrations, an art contest and a Wild and Mild Salsa Recipe Contest.
- 4. Riverside Transit Agency-\$300 to assist with the luncheon costs of the Transportation Now Meetings. These funds will assist with providing lunch for three meetings.
