



BACKGROUND: The Southern California Energy Summit on Oct. 4th at the Palm Springs Convention Center will feature presentations, panel discussions, interactive exhibits and includes seven counties in California. This year's Energy Summit theme is "Powering a Regional Clean Energy Economy." It will be hosted by the following regional partners: Coachella Valley Association of Governments, Southern California Association of Governments, Western Riverside Council of Governments, San Bernardino Associated Governments, Eastern Sierra Council of Governments, Coachella Valley Economic Partnership, Inland Empire Economic Partnership, and Imperial Valley Economic Development Corporation.

The Promotores (Community Health Workers) conference will be held on Oct. 19th at UC Riverside Palm Desert Campus. Workshops will be held to train the promotores to reach out to underserved communities.

Operation SafeHouse operates the SafeHOuse of the Desert facility in Thousand Palms that provides an emergency shelter and intervention services for homeless youth.

The Debbie Chisholm Memorial Foundation will be hosting the second annual "Cops 4Kids With Cancer" event to benefit seriously ill children.
