

BACKGROUND: The County of Riverside, along with Denim Day USA, participated in a sexual assault awareness campaign in April 2013. The County of Riverside decided on a countywide jean sticker campaign to help raise money for local non-profit organizations. The Sexual Assault Awareness Campaign began on April 1st and ended on July 31st, 2013. Over 20 departments within the County of Riverside participated, and contributed by employees purchasing stickers that entitled them to wear jeans or tennis shoes to work for one day. Tickets were sold for \$2 each, and at the end of the campaign, Riverside County employees helped raise \$25,700.00 for an outstanding cause. The listed non-profit organizations will benefit from this very important fundraising campaign.

One hundred percent of all funds will be evenly divided between these four non-profit organizations, which results in donating \$6,425.00 to each organization.
