BACKGROUND: Heritage High School is raising funds for their Visual and Performing Arts Programs for the drama, choir and band programs. St. James Community Food Pantry was established in 2009 to provide meals for disadvantaged families in the Perris Valley and currently providing 1,000 residents a month.. The Banning Police Athletics League (BPAL) will host the annual "Shop with a Hero" program, providing funds for disadvantaged children who will shop for the holidays with a police officer. The Family Service Association is holding their 6th Annual Festival of Baskets benefitting senior citizens at the Norton Younglove Community Center. These funds improve the quality of life throughout the 5th district and I urge the Board to approve these uses of the Community Improvement Designation funds.
