BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside County Foundation on Aging- \$5,000** funding will be used to assist the foundation with their Holiday Gift Program. Through this program, seniors are selected from each Senior Center in the 1st District to receive a Stater Bros Gift Card to be used for the holidays.
- 2. Community Outreach Ministry -\$500** funds will be used to benefit their Christmas Program which provides clothing for 200 children of prisoners, at-risk and needy minors (0-18 years of age) as well as a holiday meal on December 15th.
- 3. Riverside Dickens Festival -\$2,500** funds will be used to benefit the 2014 Festival and help continue making this a free event for all.
