The undersigned, Contractor, having carefully examined the site and the Contract Documents for the construction of Airport Boulevard (Avenue 56), At Grapefruit Boulevard (Hwy 111) and Union Pacific Railroad, Grade Separation Project, In the Community of Thermal of the Coachella Valley, Project No. A6-0241, State Project ID: TCIFL- 5956(216) hereby proposes to construct the work in accordance with the Contract Documents, including Addenda Number(s) 1,2,3,4 (Fill in addenda numbers if addenda have been issued.) for the amount stated in this Bid.

By submitting this Bid, Contractor agrees with County:

1. That unless withdrawn in person by Contractor or some person authorized in writing by Contractor (not by telephone or facsimile) before the time specified in the Notice Inviting Bids for the public opening of bids, this Bid constitutes an irrevocable offer for 90 calendar days after that date.
2. County has the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive any irregularities or informalities contained in a Bid.
3. To execute the Contract and deliver the Performance Bond, Payment Bond and Insurance Certificate with endorsements, that comply with the requirements set forth in the Instructions to Bidders and General Conditions, within ten (10) business days of the date of the Notice of Acceptance of Bid and Intent to Award as issued by the County.
4. That the contract shall be awarded upon a resolution or minute order to that effect duly adopted by the governing body of County; and that execution of the Contract shall constitute a written memorial thereof.
5. To submit to the County such information as County may require determining whether a particular Bid is the lowest responsible bid submitted.
6. That the accompanying Bid Bond, certified check or cashier's check is in an amount not less than 10% of the total bid submitted and constitutes a guarantee that if awarded the contract, Contractor will execute the Contract and deliver the required bonds within ten (10) business days after notice of award. If Contractor fails to execute and deliver said documents, the bond or check is to be charged with the costs of the resultant damages to the County, including but not limited to: publication costs, the difference in money between the amount bid and the amount in excess of the bid which it costs County to do or cause to be done for the work involved, lease and rental costs, additional salaries and overhead, increased interest and costs of funding the project, attorney expense, additional engineering and architectural expense and cost of maintaining or constructing alternate facilities occasioned by the failure to execute and deliver said documents.
7. By signing this Bid the Contractor certifies that the representations made therein are made under penalty of perjury.
