BACKGROUND:

Summary

This Amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department, with the deletion of 2.5 Deputy Sheriff positions, from a total of five Deputies who were fulfilling the duties of School Resource Officers on the city contract. Summary (Continued)

Please note that with the ratification of this service amendment the Department is neither deleting positions nor adjusting for a revenue loss, as the positions are being redeployed for the same service pursuant to a new two-year service agreement with the Temecula Valley Unified School District. The Sheriff's Department is also recommending Board approval of the school district agreement in a separate item on today's agenda.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The Sheriff's contract actions specified here will not have any impact on citizens and businesses since the total number of School Resource Officers purchased for contract service remains unchanged.

SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND CITY OF TEMECULA

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of its Sheriff's Department, and the City of Temecula, a General Law City, approved by the Board of Supervisors on August 10, 2010, for services effective July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2015, as amended July 17, 2012, is hereby amended in the following respects only:
