

#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### Summary

By Minute Order dated August 20, 2013 (Agenda Item 3-103), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Grand Avenue and Blackwell Boulevard Traffic Signal, Lighting, and Intersection Improvements Project in the community of Lakeland Village.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders are required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their Contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

Five bids were received on September 11, 2013, ranging from \$659,661 to \$833,883. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest and best bid was submitted by Hillcrest Contracting, Inc. of Corona, CA in the amount of \$659,661, which is \$113,145 (20.7%) higher than the Engineer's Estimate.

The Contract includes one base bid schedule and one alternate bid schedule. The alternate bid schedule provides for the contractor to do Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District (EVMWD) construction items. EVMWD concurs with bid prices for the alternate bid schedule as bid by Hillcrest Contracting, Inc. and the costs for the work will be funded by the EVMWD. By Minute Order dated April 9, 2013 (Agenda Item 3-32), the reimbursement Agreement with the EVMWD was executed by the Board of Supervisors.

The construction duration set for this project is for 45 working days.

The contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the Contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents, which meet the requirements of the Contract.

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

The construction of the traffic signal will improve traffic operations and safety through the intersection. Intersection improvements also include construction of sidewalk, curb ramps to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements, and other associated improvements.

#### SUPPLEMENTAL:

#### **Additional Fiscal Information**

The Contract is recommended to be awarded to Hillcrest Contracting, Inc. for the total amount of \$659,661. Construction is planned to finish in FY 2013/2014.

This project is funded by the Redevelopment Agency, West County DIF Signal Mitigation Fund, and the EVMWD. There are no General Funds used in this project. See Attachment "A."

Annual maintenance cost for the traffic signal is estimated to be \$7,000.

#### Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and Hillcrest Contracting, Inc., hereafter called "Contractor".

### WITNESSETH

#### **Recitals:**

- 1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, Grand Avenue and Blackwell Boulevard, Traffic Signal, Lighting and Intersection Improvements Project, Community of Lakeland Village, Project No. C0-0533, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
- 2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

#### Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

#### 1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (1) The Plans, (m) Addenda <u>1 and 2</u>, (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work, (o) Any Change Orders issued, (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

#### 2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

### 3. <u>Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion</u>

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06,"Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07 "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.03, "Beginning of Work" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within <u>fifteen (15)</u> calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

#### 4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.




