On motion of Supervisor Ashley, seconded by Supervisor Benoit, and duly carried by unanimous vote, IT WAS ORDERED that the meeting of Tuesday, December 10, 2013, be adjourned in memory of Else Brigitte Lange Page, the City of Banning's first woman mayor and former Gazette columnist for nearly 25 years.

Known by her friends as Brigitte, she moved to Banning with her husband Bill in 1957 and became an instrumental force in the community. She was co-owner and business manager of Page Auto Exchange/Page Datsun until the business was sold in 1979. She was Banning's first woman mayor after being elected to the City Council from 1975-1984 and was the first woman president of the Riverside County Mayors' and Councilmen's Conference.

Brigitte served in numerous organizations including commissioner of the Riverside Housing Authority; co-chairwoman of Banning's Redevelopment Agency Task Force; founder of Riverside County Community Action Agency; president of the Riverside Transit Authority; founder of the San Gorgonio Pass Hospital Foundation; and founding president of the San Gorgonio Child Care Consortium. Brigitte was most proud of her association with the Soroptimist Club Federation and for being co-founder of the Soroptimist House of Hope in 1981, a home for alcohol and chemically dependent women in Desert Hot Springs, which established a second home in Banning in 1989.

Among the many honors and awards Brigitte received are the City of Banning's Citizen of the Year from the Banning Chamber of Commerce in 1969; Riverside County's Volunteer of the Year in 1986; City of Banning's Community Service Award, Anthropol's Women's Club in 1987 and 1994; Riverside County's Board of Supervisors Volunteer Service Award in 1988; 68th Assembly District's Woman of Year in 1988; City of Banning's Community Recognition Award in 1999; and the City of Banning's First "Ring of Honor" Recipient in 2000.

Brigitte was a loving and devoted wife, mother, step-mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, great-great-grandmother, and friend whose memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved her. She will be greatly missed.
