BACKGROUND:

Summary

The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) awarded the County an additional \$141,284 to continue the Anti-Human Trafficking Task force Grant through June 30, 2014. Grant funds will continue to ensure the multi-disciplinary participation with federal, state and local law enforcement agencies, prosecution and non-governmental organizations for the purpose of identifying trafficking victims. The Department will require budget adjustments in the amount of \$141,284.

Operation SafeHouse, a non-governmental, non-profit organization, is the task force core collaborative partner for this project. The Board should note that, as a grant project partner, Operation SafeHouse will be utilized as a sole source contractor.

The grant award period is October 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. County Counsel has approved the documents as to form.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The grant funds 100% of total project cost and provides resources in the County to educate, prevent and intervene and treat victims of sex trafficking, labor trafficking and exploitation. Operation SafeHouse, a non-governmental, non-profit organization will assist other activists and communities to develop effective anti-human trafficking programs in their locales.
