BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

County Counsel operates as a General Support Service (GSS) and must recover costs through charges to customers. County Counsel is funded through a combination of general funds and direct billing from outside revenue sources. Rates were derived by combining direct and indirect costs incurred by direct service billable hours incurred to run and operate the department.

County Counsel has no ability to absorb any increased costs, except through full cost recovery in our billable rates. Our rates are also used to bill against Deposit Based Fees and some external non-county agencies, such as Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO), Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP), First Five, School Districts, Riverside County Habitat Conservation Agency (RCHCA) and Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC), as well as other direct bill clients with outside funding sources.

County Counsel's goal is to provide cost-effective legal services designed to promote the public service objective of the County of Riverside, while at the same time protecting them County from risk and loss.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

There is minimal to no impact on Residents and Businesses. Rates would be used for Deposit Based Fees.

The recommended action requests that the Board approve County Counsel's proposed billable hourly rates for Fiscal Year 2014-2015. The Auditor-Controller's Office has reviewed the proposed rate and methodology.
