BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Fire & Burn Foundation - \$2,000** funding will go to support the Winter Youth Camp for Burn Survivor Children & Young Adults. This camp provides a relaxed social setting offering burn-injured children the support and counseling needed to re-establish and enhance their self-esteem.
2. **The City of Riverside, Community Development Department-\$2,500** funds will be used to support the GrowRiverside: Citrus and Beyond! Conference. The conference will primarily be dedicated to helping existing and prospective farmers diversify and launch new sustainable agriculture-related business. Over 250 participants are expected to attend.
