**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Fire & Burn Foundation \$2,000 funding will go to support the Winter Youth Camp for Burn Survivor Children & Young Adults. This camp provides a relaxed social setting offering burninjured children the support and counseling needed to re-establish and enhance their self-esteem.
