BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

According to GFOA, the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting Program has been promoting the preparation and distribution of high quality *state and local financial reports* since 1945. Top-quality financial reporting is essential if governments are to be fully accountable to their citizens and to others with an interest in the government's financials.

More than 3,900 governments participate in the program each year. Participants include governments of all levels (state and local), types (general-purpose and special-purpose), and sizes.

PAFR

The Award for Outstanding Achievement in Popular Annual Financial Reporting is awarded by the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) of the United States and Canada. This is the 7th consecutive year the County has received this prestigious award.

Popular Annual Financial Reporting Awards Program was established in 1991 to encourage state and local governments to extract information from their Comprehensive Annual Financial Report to produce high quality Popular Annual Financial Reports (PAFR). The goal is to produce PAFRs which are easily understandable and readily available to the general public and other interested parties without a background in public finance. GFOA recognizes individual governments that are successful in achieving this goal.

More than 230 governments participate in the program each year. Participants include governments of various types (general-purpose and special-purpose), and sizes.

To ensure that the public has various ways of accessing County's financial information, copies of the fiscal year 2011-12 CAFR and PAFR, as filed on agenda item 2.6 dated January 15, 2013, have been made available on our website at www.auditorcontroller.org.
