### **BACKGROUND:**

#### Summary

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that all substantial amendments to the County's Five-Year Consolidated Plan and the One-Year Action Plan are subject to the citizen participation process and are approved by the Board of Supervisors and HUD in accordance with the County of Riverside Citizen Participation Plan for the 2009-2014 Five Year Consolidated Plan (Citizen Participation Plan). All new activities added to the One-Year Action Plan, as well as any significant increases in funding to an existing project, are considered to be substantial amendments.

The projects, as described in Attachments A, have been determined by staff to be eligible activities that meet a National Objective of the HOME program. Staff recommends approval of the new projects as substantial amendments.

Pursuant to 24 CFR 91.105 and the Citizen Participation Plan, the Economic Development Agency published the required public notices notifying the public of the comment period for the proposed substantial amendments to the 2013-2014 One-Year Action Plan, of the 2009-2014 Five-Year Consolidated Plan. No public comments have been received.

## Impact of Residents and Businesses

Approving this item will have a positive impact on the citizens and businesses of the Eastern Coachella Valley. The projects are expected to generate construction, permanent maintenance and property management jobs, and provide affordable housing for residents.

#### Additional Fiscal Information

No impact upon the County's General Fund; the County's contribution for the two proposed projects will be fully funded with HOME Investment Partnerships Act Funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The direct staffing funding amounts referenced in Attachment A are staffing costs associated to administer the proposed projects, which were budgeted in the 2013-2014 One-Year Action Plan which was approved by the Board on May 7, 2013.
