BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

The Corrections Division has secured, via the County's bidding process, a vendor for the purchase of a secured computerized electronic key control and accountability system for each jail facility. The computerized electronic key control system provides a systematic process to track and secure facility keys. Such a system will allow each facility to quickly identify and track each key set electronically. Currently, each facility distributes keys during shift changes and keys are handed from one staff member to another. All of the key sets are then accounted for after this exchange takes place. This system will allow each facility to electronically assign and account for each key set in real time.

The computerized electronic key control system strengthens jail security by improving the process of assigning facility keys to staff members and by providing the facility the ability to account for all key sets in real time. The computerized electronic key control system includes: numerical identified sealed key rings with smart chips that identifies users; an alarm to alert supervisors if key sets are not returned or leave the facility; a report to identify chain of custody, and biometric readers that only allows assigned user to remove key sets for assigned housing units. Furthermore, the system has the capacity to add more cabinets to accommodate growth.
