## **Summary (continued)**

Pavement Recycling Systems, Inc. submitted the only response/quote to the Request for Qualifications (RFQ). Purchasing performed post bid inquiries of all non-responding vendors and found these vendors either lacked the expertise and/or desire to provide the requested services.

This contract will allow Pavement Recycling Systems, Inc. to cold plane (wedge plane), as needed, along existing curb and gutter within the Homeland/Romoland, Hemet, Beaumont, and Bermuda Dunes areas ahead of asphalt overlay that will be performed by County personnel under a force account.

The total cost of the work is \$78,489.

# **Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

The proposal submitted by Pavement Recycling Systems, Inc. was reviewed by an evaluation team consisting of personnel from the Transportation Department and Purchasing Department. The evaluation team reviewed the proposal based on the bidder's overall responsiveness to the requirements of the scope of service, ability to perform, equipment capability, and overall cost.

The evaluation committee recommends that the award be given to Pavement Recycling Systems, Inc. as the responsive/responsible vendor at the contract amount of \$78,489.
