**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

California Elections Code §§ 10002, 10402, and 10403 allow jurisdictions to request that the Board of Supervisors approve the Registrar of Voters to conduct and consolidate elections by submitting a resolution requesting these services. The attached Exhibit A lists jurisdictions that have requested the Registrar of Voters to conduct and consolidate their elections. The department has the resources to provide these services. The county will not be reimbursed for the federal and state office's elections but the Registrar of Voters will receive reimbursements from local jurisdictions for the full cost of conducting their election.

Approximately \$900,000 of the total election costs will be reimbursed and \$1,600,000 will come from general funds.
