



On motion of Supervisor Benoit, seconded by Supervisor Stone, and duly carried by unanimous vote, IT WAS ORDERED that the meeting of Tuesday, June 3, 2014, be adjourned in memory of Nellie Hernandez, a 71-year-old resident of Indio who passed away on May 6, 2014.

Born on November 14, 1942 in Juarez, Mexico, Nellie was "highly respected and loved" throughout the Coachella Valley. As the first in her family to become an American citizen, she completed her doctorate program in Counseling Psychology. She served as a Deputy Probation Officer for the County of Riverside for 30 years. She then went on to fulfill her "passion" for helping others by working as a Marriage and Family counselor at Family Services of the Desert and at the Riverside County Latino Commission.

Nellie was a loving and devoted mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, sister, and friend who "believed in the importance of dedication and perseverance." Her memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved her. She will be dearly missed.
