ORDINANCE NO. 784.10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 784 CREATING THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY CHILDREN AND FAMILIES COMMISSION PURSUANT TO HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 130140

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Subsections D through G of Section 5 of Ordinance No. 784 are repealed in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 784 is amended to read as follows:

Section 6. TERM.

- A. Commission members shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors. Commission members who are appointed by the Board of Supervisors shall serve a term of office for three years, absent removal by the Board of Supervisors. No Commission member appointed by the Board of Supervisors may serve more than two consecutive terms (term limit).
- B. After a Commission member has served two consecutive terms, the member may be reappointed by the Board of Supervisors two years following the last day of the end of a term limit.

Section 3. Section 12 of Ordinance 784 is amended to read as follows:

Section 12. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

- A. An advisory committee is established to provide technical and professional expertise and support for any purpose that will be beneficial in accomplishing the purpose of the Act. Upon the request of the Commission, the advisory committee shall make recommendations and reports to the Commission.
- B. Membership of the advisory committee will consist of representation of diverse interests, geographical regions, economic backgrounds, cultural and ethnic heritage of County residents with technical expertise or experience specific to children 0 through 5 years of age.
- C. The number of members of the advisory committee will be a maximum of ten (10) persons, two appointments from each supervisorial district.
- D. The individual term of the advisory committee members will be for two years beginning with the date of appointment. There will be no limit to the number of terms an individual can serve on the committee, so long as the member actively participates in committee activities.
- E. The advisory committee will annually elect a chair and vice chair.

Section 4. Section 13 of Ordinance 784 is amended to read as follows:

Section 12. DUTIES OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

- A. The purpose of the advisory committee is to:
1. Provide technical and professional expertise as well as ongoing support to the Commission for any purpose that will contribute to accomplishing the purpose of the Act and the local strategic plan.
 2. Enhance the reputation and credibility of the Commission through increased engagement and communication with relevant stakeholders and the community at large, as directed by the Commission.
- B. The members of the advisory committee serve without compensation, but may receive actual and necessary expenses as incurred in carrying out their duties.
- C. The members of the advisory committee have no authority to make, change or implement policy, unless formal action is taken by the Commission.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its adoption.
