SUBJECT: Approval to add additional outside veterinarians as needed, and to increase the aggregated annual amount from \$450,000 to \$500,000 for FY 14/15. [Districts – All] [\$500,000]

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve the one year Agreements with the updated list of vendors listed in Attachment A for \$500,000 for FY 14/15;
- 2. Exempt the County Purchasing Agent from the sole source requirement when adding new vendors not to exceed \$100,000 without securing competitive bids in accordance with Ordinance 459 while staying with the Board approved aggregate amount of \$500,000; and
- 3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459, to increase or decrease the Agreements listed in Attachment A while staying within the approved aggregate amount of \$500,000 based upon the availability of funding and sign amendments that do change the substantive terms of the Agreements through June 30, 2015.

BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

Riverside County Ordinance No. 560 was approved by the voters on November 2, 1976 and became effective on November 12, 1976. The Ordinance authorizes low cost pet spay and neuter services for Riverside County residents. Currently, qualified staff and contracted veterinarians provide these services. However, the demand for services far exceeds the allocated funding. The department requests approval to increase the annual aggregate from \$450,000 to \$500,000 for fiscal year 14/15.

Currently, the department works with several contracted veterinarians whose schedules do not always allow adequate time to work with the Riverside County Animal Services. Therefore, the department requests that contracted veterinarians be added and deleted as necessary; without exceeding the aggregated annual approved amount, in order to meet the demands of the department.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

These services provide spay, neuter surgeries for animals sheltered throughout Riverside County, at all three shelters.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

There is no additional impact on the general fund as this funding has been included in the department's budget. The contractor's fee is offset by the fees charged for pet sterilization services. The County will charge \$40.00 per cat and \$85.00 per dog or rate approved through County Ordinance 560.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Purchasing released a Request for Qualification (RFQ#HSARC-149) in 2011, mailing solicitations to fourteen (14) companies/individuals, and advertised on the County's internet. The proposals were reviewed by an evaluation team consisting of personnel from Purchasing and DAS. All contractors receive the same rate of \$750.00 per full day worked. If contracted veterinarian works less than a full day, the County will pay Contractor at a rate of \$85.00 per hour for the hours worked.
